Dear Refuse User,

On July 14, the City of St. Louis Board of Aldermen approved an increase in the monthly refuse fee from \$11 per unit to \$14 per unit, effective August 1, 2017. The Board Bill, introduced and passed by the Board of Aldermen, plans to repair and replace old trash trucks, install cameras in alleyways to deter illegal dumping, and improve refuse pickup in your neighborhood.

I realize that increases in the cost of services are rarely met with enthusiasm. As Collector of Revenue, my job is to collect and administer your payments as carefully and efficiently as possible. To assist you, my office provides a variety of fast and convenient ways to pay your bills, one of which is our Direct Payment program.

The Direct Payment program eliminates the need to write checks, buy stamps, or wait in line and has no additional fees or service charges attached. It also ensures your payments will always be made on time, preventing service disruption. There is no charge to enroll and you can opt out at any time. For your convenience, I've enclosed a Direct Payment application.
