

ORDINANCE 71037
BOARD BILL NUMBER 116 CS INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JOSEPH
VACCARO

1 An ordinance adopted and approved pursuant to § 70.815 RSMo, authorizing the Police
2 Commissioner to make a contract on behalf of the City of St. Louis with St. Louis County
3 allowing St. Louis County to provide police services on MetroLink Property within the city
4 limits of the City of St. Louis, including exercising powers of arrest for criminal offenses and
5 violations of the ordinances of the City of St. Louis the same as possessed by the police officers
6 of the City of St. Louis, and with the same immunity as if acting within St. Louis County, and
7 containing an Emergency Clause.

8 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

9 **SECTION ONE.** Definitions: As used herein, unless context plainly indicates otherwise, the
10 following terms shall have the hereinafter ascribed meanings:

11 A. “MetroLink” means the light rail passenger system operated by the Bi-State
12 Development Agency of the Missouri-Illinois Metropolitan District d/b/a “Metro” (the
13 “Agency”);

14 B. “Metrolink Property” means and includes all real and personal property and
15 equipment, including without limitation, rights of way and related trackage, rails, rail cars or rail
16 vehicles, signals, power, fuel, communication and ventilation systems, power plants, stations,
17 terminals, signage, storage yards, depots, repair and maintenance shops, yards, offices, parking
18 lots and other real estate or personal property used or held by the Agency for or incidental to the
19 operation, rehabilitation or improvement of MetroLink.

20 **SECTION TWO.** The purpose of this ordinance is to secure the adequate provision of police
21 services on MetroLink, a public service that traverses the borders of the City of St. Louis and St.
22 Louis County.

1 **SECTION THREE.** Pursuant to § 70.815 RSMo, the Police Commissioner is hereby
2 authorized to make and enter into a contract on behalf of the City of the St. Louis with St. Louis
3 County allowing for St. Louis County to provide police services on MetroLink property within
4 the city limits of the City of St. Louis, including exercising powers of arrest for criminal offenses
5 and violations of the ordinances of the City of St. Louis the same as possessed by the police
6 officers of the City of St. Louis, and with the same immunity as if acting within St. Louis
7 County, and such other terms as are reasonably calculated to further the purposes of this
8 ordinance. The Police Commissioner is further authorized to make and enter into such
9 amendments to the contract as he shall deem appropriate.

10 **SECTION FOUR.** Upon the execution of this contract, the police officers of St. Louis County
11 shall have powers of arrest, including the power to effect arrests for criminal offenses and
12 violations of the ordinances of the City of St. Louis, the same as possessed by the police officers
13 of the City of St. Louis, and with the same immunity as if acting within St. Louis County.

14 **SECTION FIVE.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance necessary for the immediate
15 preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
16 within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 or Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis
17 and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval
18 by the Mayor.
