ORDINANCE 71107

BOARD BILL NUMBER 196 INTRODUCED BY: ALDERMAN JOE VACCARO

1 An Ordinance establishing a three-way stop site at the intersection of Mardel Avenue
2 and Macklind Avenue regulating all traffic traveling eastbound on Mardel Avenue at Macklind
3 Avenue and regulating all traffic traveling northbound and southbound on Macklind Avenue at
4 Mardel Avenue, and containing an emergency clause.

5 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

6 **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby established a three-way stop site for all traffic
7 approaching the intersection of Mardel Avenue and Macklind Avenue by regulating all traffic
8 traveling eastbound on Mardel Avenue at Macklind Avenue and regulating all traffic traveling
9 northbound and southbound on Macklind Avenue at Mardel Avenue. The Director of Streets is
10 hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic
11 approaching this intersection.

12 **SECTION TWO. EMERGENCY CLAUSE:** This being an Ordinance for the
13 preservation of public peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency
14 measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of
15 St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and
16 approval by the Mayor.
