1 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Fire Commissioner, on behalf of the Mayor and
2 the City of Saint Louis, to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Transfer Agreement with
3 the Missouri Department of Social Services MO Healthnet Division for a Ground Emergency
4 Medical Transportation (GEMT) program for uncompensated Medicaid cost associated with
5 GEMT services pursuant to RSMo 208.1032, establishing a fund from which to pay the non-
6 federal share of the reconciled costs reimbursements and the administrative fee, providing for
7 appropriation of the funds subsequently paid through the Missouri Department of Social
8 Services, authorizing the expenditure of such appropriated funds by entering into contracts or
9 otherwise upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, and containing an
10 emergency clause.

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

12 **SECTION ONE.** The Fire Commissioner is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the
13 City of St. Louis, to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Missouri
14 Department of Social Services subject to approval by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment.

15 **SECTION TWO.** The Fire Commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to ensure that
16 the City complies with any requests for information or similar data requirements imposed by the
17 Department of Social Services for purposes of obtaining supporting documentation necessary to
18 claim federal funds or to obtain federal approvals.

19 **SECTION THREE.** Upon receipt of payments, the Fire Commissioner is hereby authorized
20 and directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to deposit such funds
21 for a special fund (Fund 1116, Center 6110014) for the purpose of providing funding for
22 payment of the non-federal share, the administrative fee to the Missouri Department of Social
23 Services, and the remainder for purchase of capital assets and other equipment and related
24 supplies for the Fire Department.

25 **SECTION FOUR.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate preservation
26 of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate measure within the
27 meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore
28 this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
