

ORDINANCE 71259

BOARD BILL NUMBER 148 AS AMENDED INTRODUCED BY: ALDERMAN JOHN COATAR

1 An ordinance for the adoption of the 2020 edition of the Revised Code of the City of St. Louis,
2 Annotated, with the Charter, tables, and cross-references to former Codes included, and
3 providing for the retention, distribution, and supplementation of the Revised Code; and with an
4 emergency clause.

5 **WHEREAS**, the code of ordinances of a general and permanent nature of the City of St. Louis
6 was last revised in 1994; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen previously appropriated funds for the purpose of preparing
8 and publishing a revised code of ordinances of a general and permanent nature to update the
9 1994 Revised Code, eliminating obsolete, repealed or revised ordinances and incorporating
10 ordinances enacted in the interim since 1994; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen authorized the City Counselor to supervise the preparation
12 of a new Revised Code of the City of St. Louis; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the City Counselor has contracted with Municipal Code Corporation, and has
14 completed the preparation of a Revised Code of the City St. Louis;

15 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

16 **SECTION ONE.** Ordinance 63235 is hereby repealed.

17 **SECTION TWO.** There is hereby adopted Chapter 1.01 of the Revised Code of the City of
18 St. Louis as follows:

19 **1.01.010. Code adopted.**

1 The Code entitled "Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020, Annotated" published by
2 Municipal Code Corporation, consisting of Titles 1 through 26 is adopted. The Code embraces
3 ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted on or before December 31, 2019. The
4 Revised Code herein provided for shall also contain the Charter of the City of St. Louis, as
5 amended, the "Scheme of Separation of the City of St. Louis and the County of St. Louis,"
6 annotations, cross-reference tables to previous codes, ordinance disposition tables, and index.

7 **1.01.020 Code kept by Register—Distribution.**

8 The new Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020, Annotated, as herein adopted, shall be
9 kept in the Office of the Register of the City of Saint Louis, as a part of the ordinance codified in
10 this chapter and there kept for public record as provided for ordinances of the City; and copies of
11 such code that shall have been printed on authority of the City of Saint Louis, shall be kept by the
12 Register and distributed according to law, and attested as such according to RSMo 82.200, by
13 authentication of the Register, and bear the Seal of the City of Saint Louis.

14 **1.01.030 Code as proof of ordinances—Effect of adoption.**

15 The Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020, Annotated, shall be taken as prima facie proof
16 of the City ordinances or part thereof of the ordinances so codified therein; provided further, the
17 adoption of such new Code shall not work to effect any change, repeal or amendment of an
18 ordinance or provision thereof, or affect any rights, benefits, duties, disabilities, liabilities,
19 punishments, fines or forfeitures, or any other matters whatsoever past, present or future, except
20 as specifically provided in this chapter.

1 **1.01.040 Official codification designated.**

2 From the time of the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter, the official codification
3 and revision of the City's ordinances shall be the Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020,
4 Annotated, and the prior Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated, shall no longer
5 have any legal effect as a revision and codification of the ordinances of the City.

6 **1.01.050 Incorporation of subsequent ordinances.**

7 All ordinances enacted after the adoption of the Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020,
8 Annotated, shall be incorporated into such Code by periodic supplementation as hereinafter
9 provided, and such supplements shall be taken as prima facie proof as provided by Section
10 1.10.030 hereof.

11 **1.01.060 Supplements to the Code.**

12 The City Counselor of the City shall have charge and control of the supplementation of the Revised
13 Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020, Annotated, and such supplementation shall include such
14 annotation, corrections of discovered errors or omissions as may be found to exist in the Code or
15 supplements thereto; the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City shall have authority, as
16 appropriated funds obtain, to provide by contract for the editing, printing, publishing, and
17 incidental expenses of such supplements in assistance to the City Counselor; and such supplements
18 shall be filed and recorded in the Register's Office and distributed as provided by Chapter 1.04.

1 **1.01.070 Abbreviations for reference to the Code.**

2 References to the Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020, Annotated, may be abbreviated
3 to more conveniently identify such Code by use of the terms "Rev. Code St. Louis, 2020, Anno.,"
4 or "R.C. St. Louis, 2020, Anno." or "Code" where in context it clearly appears that the Revised
5 Code of the City of Saint Louis, 2020, Annotated, is referred to; and to indicate a time of
6 supplementation the suffix "Supplement, 20 _____ " indicating the year, or an
7 abbreviation "Sup. 20 _____ " may be used.

8 SECTION THREE. Emergency Clause. The passage of this ordinance being deemed necessary
9 for immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared
10 to exist within the meaning of Section 20 of Article IV of the Charter, and this ordinance shall be
11 in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

BOARD BILL NO. [94] 100

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DANIEL MCGUIRE

An ordinance repealing Ordinance 58431, which is codified as Chapter 1.01, of the *Revised Code Of The City Of Saint Louis, 1980, Annotated*, and adopting in lieu thereof a new Chapter 1.01, pertaining to a new revised and codified arrangement of the ordinances of the City of Saint Louis, to be known as the *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*, consisting of: "Volume I," and "Volume II," containing in new revised and codified arrangement: the Charter of the City and Scheme of Separation, annotated; the ordinances of the City of a general and permanent nature in force to and including Ordinance 63151, approved May 2, 1994, annotated; cross-reference tables to the location in such new Code of ordinances contained within the *Revised Code Of The City of Saint Louis, 1948*, and the *Revised Code of the City of St. Louis, 1960*; an ordinance disposition table accounting for and locating the ordinances presently in force to and including Ordinance 63151, approved May 2, 1994; and an "Index" locating the several Charter and ordinances and parts thereof in the new Code's two volumes: providing that such new Code shall be kept in the Office of the City Register as a public record, and that copies of such Code printed by authority of the City are to be kept and distributed by the Register as provided by law, attested to and authenticated as true copies and bear the Seal of the City; providing that such new Code, and its supplements shall be prima facie proof of ordinances, and that the new Code shall not cause a repeal or amendment of ordinances nor affect any rights or duties prior existent except as specifically provided in this ordinance; that the new Code shall be the official revision and codification and the said Code of 1980, shall no longer be of any legal effect; providing that the new Code shall be kept current by periodic supplementation and annotation by the City Counselor, and authorizing the Mayor and Comptroller to contract for the editing, printing and publishing of such annotated supplements; establishing simplified, approved terminology for identifying the new Code and its supplements; and containing an effective date clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Ordinance 58431, approved November 18, 1981 and codified as Chapter 1.01 - CODE ADOPTION of the *Revised Code of the City of Saint*

Louis, 1980, Annotated, is hereby repealed, and enacted in lieu thereof is a new Chapter 1.01 to read as follows in Sections Two through Eight.

SECTION TWO: 1.01.010 Documents adopted as *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*. There is hereby adopted as the new code of the City of Saint Louis a *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*, consisting of: "Volume I" and "Volume II", containing in new revised and codified arrangement: the *Charter of the City of Saint Louis, 1914*, as amended to April 18, 1994, and annotated; the "Scheme of Separation of the City of Saint Louis and the County of Saint Louis;" the ordinances of a general and permanent nature of the City of Saint Louis in force to and including Ordinance 63151, approved May 2, 1994, with annotations; cross reference tables to the location in such new Code of ordinances contained with the *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1948*, and the *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1960*; an ordinance disposition table accounting for and locating the ordinances presently in force to and including Ordinance 63151, approved May 2, 1994; and an "Index" locating the several Charter and ordinances and parts thereof in the new Code's two volumes.

SECTION THREE: 1.01.020 Code kept by Register- Distribution. The new *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*, as herein adopted, shall be kept in the Office of the Register of the City of Saint Louis, as a part of this ordinance and there kept for public record as provided for ordinances of the city; and copies of such code that shall have been printed on authority of the City of Saint Louis, shall be kept by the Register and distributed according to law, and attested as such according to Section 82.200, Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1986, as amended, by authentication of the Register, and bear the Seal of the City of Saint Louis.

SECTION FOUR: 1.01.030 Code as proof of ordinances - Effect of adoption. The *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*, shall be taken as prima facie proof of the City ordinances or part thereof of the ordinances so codified therein; provided further, the adoption of such new Code shall not work to effect any change, repeal or amendment of an ordinance or provision thereof, or affect any rights, benefits, duties, disabilities, liabilities, punishments, fines or forfeitures, or any other matters whatsoever past, present or future, except as specifically provided in this Chapter.

SECTION FIVE: 1.01.040 Official codification designated. From the time of the effective date of this ordinance, the official codification and revision of the City's ordinances shall be the *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*, and the prior *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1980*,

Annotated, shall no longer have any legal effect as a revision and codification of the ordinances of the City.

SECTION SIX: 1.01.050 Incorporation of subsequent ordinances. All ordinances enacted after the adoption of the Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, *Annotated*, shall be incorporated into such Code by periodic supplementation as hereinafter provided, and such supplements shall be taken as prima facie proof as provided by Section 1.01.030 hereof.

SECTION SEVEN: 1.01.060 Supplements to the Code. The City Counselor of the City shall have charge and control of the supplementation of the *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*, and such supplementation shall include such annotation, corrections of discovered errors or omissions as may be found to exist in the Code or supplements thereto; the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City shall have authority, as appropriated funds obtain, to provide by contract for the editing, printing, publishing, and incidental expenses of such supplements in assistance to the City Counselor; and such supplements shall be filed and recorded in the Register's Office and distributed as provided by Chapter 1.04.

SECTION EIGHT: 1.01.070 Abbreviations for reference to the Code. References to the *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated*, may be abbreviated to more conveniently identify such Code by use of the terms "Rev. Code St. Louis, 1994, Anno.," or "R.C. St. Louis, 1994, Anno.," or "Code" where in context it clearly appears that the Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, *Annotated*, is referred to; and to indicate a time of supplementation the suffix "Supplement, 19__" indicating the year, or an abbreviation "Sup. 19__" may be used.

SECTION NINE: Effective Date. The effective date of the provisions of this ordinance shall be the date of the receipt of the new *Revised Code of the City of Saint Louis, 1994, Annotated* by, the City Counselor and Register.
