

1 Avenue/Forest Park Parkway and Laclede Avenue; thence westwardly along the center
2 line of said alley to its intersection with the center line with Taylor Avenue; thence
3 northwardly along the center line of Taylor Avenue to the point of the beginning.

4 **SECTION TWO.** Paragraph (f) of Section Two of Ordinance 63780, approved on May 31,
5 1996, as amended by Ordinance 64550, approved on January 15, 1999, is hereby repealed and in
6 lieu thereof a new paragraph (f) is enacted to read as follows:

7 The tax provided for by this ordinance shall only be levied and collected for tax years
8 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018. If the District for any
9 reason is dissolved, all delinquent taxes collected after the date of dissolution shall be
10 credited and forwarded to the general fund of the City of St. Louis after all debts of the
11 District, if any, are discharged.

12 **SECTION THREE.** The continuation of the tax levy authorized in Section Two of this
13 ordinance shall not be effective unless and until the following proposition, submitted to the
14 qualified voters residing in the District at an election in the District to be held on April 7, 2009,
15 shall receive in its favor the votes of the majority of the qualified voters voting at said election
16 for or against said proposition. Said proposition shall be in substantially the following form:

18 Shall the Central West End Southeast Special Business District, as established in
19 Ordinance No. 63780, approved on May 31, 1996, amended in Ordinance No. 64550, approved
20 January 15, 1999, and amended by Ordinance _____, approved on _____, be
21 authorized to impose a tax not to exceed \$.43 per \$100.00 valuation for the tax years 2009, 2010,
22 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 on all real property located in the
23 aforementioned Central West End Southeast Special Business District?
