

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 276 INTRODUCED BY: ALDERMAN CRAIG SCHMID**

3 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor, on the behalf of the City of St. Louis, to enter
4 into agreements with the Transdisciplinary Center on Health Equity Policy Research and
5 Practice, under the Satcher Health Leadership Institute at Morehouse School of Medicine, funded
6 by the National Institute of Health's National Institute on Minority Health and Health Disparities
7 for the St. Louis Collaborative Action for Child Equity project, and authorizing the Mayor, upon
8 approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend any funds received by said
9 agreement to fulfill the obligations of the agreement, and containing an emergency clause.

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

13 **SECTION ONE:** The Mayor, on the behalf of the City of St. Louis, is hereby authorized and
14 directed to enter into agreements with the Transdisciplinary Center on Health Equity Policy
15 Research and Practice, under the Satcher Health Leadership Institute at Morehouse School of
16 Medicine, funded by the National Institute of Health's National Institute on Minority Health and
17 Health Disparities for the St. Louis Collaborative Action for Child Equity project, and
18 authorizing the Mayor, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend
19 any funds received by said agreement to fulfill the obligations of the agreement.

21 **SECTION TWO:** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public
22 peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of
23 Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and therefore, this
24 ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
