

**BOARD BILL NO. 95 INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN STEPHEN CONWAY**

1 An Ordinance adopted pursuant to Section 70.210-70.325 of the Revised Statutes of  
2 Missouri (2000); authorizing and directing the Mayor and Comptroller, on behalf of The City of  
3 St. Louis, Missouri (“City”) to execute and deliver a Memorandum of Agreement in substantially  
4 the form attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit 1, by and among the  
5 City and The Bi-State Development Agency of the Missouri-Illinois Metropolitan District  
6 (“Metro”), for the purpose of providing trash removal services and receptacles at designated  
7 metro bus stops by the City's Refuse Division as specified in a Memorandum of Agreement for a  
8 term of one year in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000); and containing an  
9 emergency clause.

10 **WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Article VI of the Missouri Constitution allows and provides  
11 that any municipality or political subdivision of the State of Missouri may contract and cooperate  
12 with other municipalities or political subdivisions thereof, for the planning, development,  
13 construction, acquisition or operation of any public improvement or facility, or for a common  
14 service, in the manner provided by law; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Sections 70.210 to 70.325 MO. Rev. Stat. (2000), as amended (herein  
16 referred to as the “Intergovernmental Agreement Act”), allow and provide, in pertinent part, for  
17 municipalities and political subdivisions of the State of Missouri to contract and cooperate with  
18 any other municipality or political subdivision for the planning, development, construction,  
19 acquisition or operation of any public improvement or facility, or for a common service; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the City and Metro have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement  
21 pertaining to providing trash receptacles and trash removal services at Metro bus stops  
22 throughout the City, and;

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1           **WHEREAS**, under said agreement, Metro is to provide Two Hundred Thousand Dollars,  
2 (\$200,000) a year for such services payable on a monthly basis in the amount of \$17,666.66 per  
3 month for trash removal services.

4 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

5           **SECTION ONE.** The Mayor and Comptroller of the City of St. Louis are hereby  
6 authorized and directed to execute the Memorandum of Agreement between the Missouri-Illinois  
7 Metropolitan District (“Metro”) and the City of St. Louis (“City”) for purposes of providing trash  
8 removal services at designated Metro bus stops in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars  
9 (\$200,000) for a term of one year from the date of execution in substantially the form attached  
10 hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit 1.

11           **SECTION TWO.** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance providing for the  
12 preservation of public health and safety and providing for current expenses of the City  
13 government, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19  
14 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall  
15 become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
