

1 **BOARD BILL NO. 81 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN DIONNE FLOWERS**

2 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of the Department of Human
3 Services, via the St. Louis Area Agency on Aging, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, to accept a
4 contract from the Missouri Alliance of Area Agencies on Aging (ma4) in the amount of
5 \$15,000.00 and to expend those funds for Benefit Enrollment activities for Adults with
6 Disabilities and Senior Citizens, as set forth in the contract attached as Exhibit A; appropriating
7 said funds and authorizing the Director of the Department of Human Services, upon approval of
8 the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend such funds as permitted by the contract;
9 and containing an Emergency Clause.

10 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

11 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of the Department of Human Services via the St. Louis
12 Area Agency on Aging, on behalf of the City of St. Louis, is hereby authorized to accept a
13 contract from the Missouri Alliance of Area Agencies on Aging (ma4) for funds in the amount
14 of \$15,000.00 which will be used for Benefit Enrollment Activities, as specified in the Grantee
15 Agreement CFDA#93.518 from the National Council on Aging with the Missouri Alliance of
16 Area Agencies on Aging, specifically to accomplish the statewide performance targets of a)
17 attracting individuals for screening and enrollment help through outreach and education; b) to
18 submit applications in core benefits for individuals; and c) to submit applications for optional
19 benefits for individuals and d) to follow-up with individuals to be sure they are receiving
20 benefits. The City of St. Louis will agree to execute subcontracts for the Benefit Enrollment
21 Activities to organizations specifically named in the SLAAA proposal to the Missouri Alliance
22 of Area Agencies on Aging (ma4), as set forth in Exhibit A.

1 **SECTION TWO.** The Director of the Department of Human Services is hereby
2 authorized and directed, upon approval of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, to expend
3 the funds, which are appropriated for said purposes, by entering into contracts or agreements
4 pursuant to the ma4 contract, in a manner that is consistent with the provisions of the contract.

5 **SECTION THREE.** Emergency Clause. This being an Ordinance for the immediate
6 preservation of public peace, public health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an immediate
7 measure within the meaning of Section 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St.
8 Louis and therefore this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and
9 approval by the Mayor.
