

St. Louis City Ordinance 63098

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the Board of Public Service to let contracts, purchase materials, equipment and supplies, employ labor, hire consultants, pay fees, salaries and wages, and do all things necessary for the improvement of the Municipal Water Works System by the relocation of approximately one thousand eight hundred (1,800) feet of twelve-inch (12') ductile iron water distribution lines on the south and west sides of Carondelet Boulevard, from Courtois Street easterly to the Interstate 55 Right of Way, the tie-in to existing service lines and any other work necessary in conjunction with the raising of Carondelet Boulevard, appropriating Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) from the Water Works Contingent Account pursuant to Section Twenty-three (23) of Ordinance No. 59597 approved November 20, 1985, containing sections for the description of work, approval of plans and specifications, work and material guarantees, estimated expenditure and reversion authorizations, reimbursement authorization, applicable state and federal wage rate requirements, equal opportunity provisions, the Mayor's Executive Orders, contract advertising statutes and an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Board of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to let contracts, purchase materials, equipment and supplies, employ labor, hire consultants, pay fees, salaries and wages, and do all things necessary for the improvement of the Municipal Water Works System by the relocation of approximately one thousand eight hundred (1,800) feet of twelve-inch (12') ductile iron water distribution lines on the south and west sides of Carondelet Boulevard, from Courtois Street easterly to the Interstate 55 Right of Way, the tie-in to existing service lines and any other work necessary in conjunction with the raising of Carondelet Boulevard.

SECTION TWO. The work provided for herein shall be carried out in accordance with detailed plans and specifications to be adopted and approved by the Board of Public Service before bids are advertised therefor.

SECTION THREE. Any contract, or contracts, shall provide that the contractor, or contractors, doing said work shall guarantee and keep in good repair all of the work and materials used in connection therewith for a term of at least one (1) year, commencing on the date of acceptance of the work by the City.

SECTION FOUR. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) from the Water Works Contingent Account pursuant to Section Twenty-three (23) of Ordinance No. 59597 approved November 20, 1985 to be expended for the work authorized under Section One of this ordinance. Any funds appropriated under this ordinance which remain after the complete and final payment for all work authorized under Section One of this ordinance shall revert to the Water Works Contingent Account.

SECTION FIVE. Any reimbursement received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency or any other Federal agency for work authorized under Section One of this ordinance shall be placed in the Water Works Contingent Account.

SECTION SIX. All construction contracts let under authority of this ordinance shall provide that no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages be paid in the City of St. Louis, as determined by the Federal Davis-Bacon Act and the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri; said prevailing wage shall be paid for each craft or type of workperson needed in the actual construction work of the job herein authorized, as well as the general prevailing rate of pay for legal holidays and overtime work shall be paid to all workers. All labor to be performed under this contract shall be subject to the provisions of Section 290.210 to 290.340 inclusive, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1986, as amended, and the Charter and Code of the City of St. Louis.

SECTION SEVEN. The Comptroller of the City of St. Louis shall be and is hereby directed to draw warrants from time to time on the Treasurer of said City for the several payments of the costs specified in Section One hereof.

SECTION EIGHT. All specifications approved by the Board of Public Service and contracts let under the authority of this ordinance shall provide for compliance with the Mayor's Executive Orders on Equal Opportunities dated March 25, 1982 and December 4, 1984, and the Mayor's Executive Order of December 22, 1986 on the selection of experts and consultants.

SECTION NINE. All advertisement for bids pursuant to this ordinance shall be subject to Section 8.250, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1986, as amended.

SECTION TEN. This being an ordinance providing for public work and improvements, and the passage thereof being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist within the meaning of Section 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
