

St. Louis City Ordinance 64070

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [97] 51

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN DANIEL J. MCGUIRE

An Ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission, the Board of Public Service, and the Board of Estimate and Apportionment amending Section Three of the Robertson Land Acquisition Ordinance 60810 approved April 11, 1988, as amended by Ordinance 62261 approved March 8, 1991, which established a multi-year Expansion and Improvement Program (the "Program") at Lambert- St. Louis International Airport for the acquisition of certain real and personal property rights for noise mitigation purposes and other necessary work and services related to the Program, authorizing the City Counselor to acquire said property rights including easements by purchase, lease or condemnation; authorizing a Fifth Supplemental Appropriating in the total amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the Passenger Facility Charge Fund established under authority of Ordinance 62501, Section 6, approved February 10, 1992, into the Robertson Land Acquisition Ordinance 60810 approved April 11, 1988, as amended, for the payment of costs authorized therein; and containing an emergency clause.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 60810 approved April 11, 1988 authorized a multi-year Expansion and Improvement Program (the "Program") at Lambert- St. Louis International Airport for the acquisition of certain property rights including easements for noise mitigation purposes and other necessary work and services related to the Program at a total estimated cost of Eleven Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$11,200,000), authorized an initial appropriation of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) for cost authorized therein, made provision for supplemental appropriations as funds become available to continue the Program, and contained an emergency clause;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 62261, approved March 8, 1991, which amended Section Four of Ordinance 60810 approved April 11, 1988, authorized the Board of Public Service to let contracts for the removal of structures and utilities on the acquired real property, and authorized the Airport Commission to let contracts and otherwise provide for ground maintenance, and contained an emergency clause;

WHEREAS, for operational purposes, it is in the best interest of the City of St. Louis to amend Section Three of Ordinance 60810 as amended, thereby authorizing the City Counselor to acquire certain property rights including easements by purchase, lease or condemnation;

WHEREAS, Ordinances 61490, 62912, 63085 and 63198 authorize supplemental appropriations in the total amount of Six Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,200,000) to continue the Program; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize a Fifth Supplemental Appropriating in the total amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the Passenger Facility Charge Fund established under authority of Ordinance 62501, Section 6, approved February 10, 1992, into the Robertson Land Acquisition Ordinance 60810 approved April 11, 1988, as amended to continue the payment of cost authorized therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Section Three of the Robertson Land Acquisition Ordinance 60810 approved April 11, 1988, as amended by Ordinance 62261 approved March 8, 1991, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in its place:

"SECTION THREE. The City Counselor is hereby authorized to acquire said property rights including easements by purchase, lease, or condemnation."

SECTION TWO. There is hereby authorized a Fifth Supplemental Appropriation in the total amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the Passenger Facility Charge Fund established under authority of Ordinance 62501, Section 6, approved February 10, 1992, into the Robertson Land Acquisition Ordinance 60810 approved April 11, 1988, as amended by Ordinance 62261 approved March 8, 1991, for the payment of costs authorized therein.

SECTION THREE. This being an ordinance providing for a public works and improvement program, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV, Section 20, of the City Charter and shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor of the City of St. Louis.
