

*St. Louis City Ordinance 64871*

FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

BOARD BILL NO. [99] 271

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN KENNETH ORTMANN

An ordinance establishing a two way stop site for all east-west traffic traveling on Arsenal Street approaching the intersection of Arsenal Street and Michigan Avenue, thereby establishing a four way stop site; containing an emergency clause.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. There is hereby established a two way stop site for all east-west traffic traveling on Arsenal Street approaching the intersection of Arsenal Street and Michigan Avenue, thereby establishing a four way stop site at such intersection. The director of streets is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic approaching this intersection.

SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
