Summary Board Bill Number 124

The proposed bill will prohibit commercial vehicles, from travelling along CD Banks Avenue from the eastern boundary of North Newstead Avenue to the eastern boundary of Pendleton Avenue. The definition of commercial vehicle excludes: pickup trucks, emergency vehicles, including privately owned tow trucks when providing emergency service to non-commercial vehicles, vehicles making deliveries to nearby addresses, and vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) of ten-thousand (10,000) pounds or less.

## BOARD BILL NUMBER 124 INTRODUCED BY: ALDERMAN JESSE TODD

An ordinance pertaining to commercial vehicles, as such term is defined herein; and

prohibiting such traffic along CD Banks Avenue from the eastern boundary of

North Newstead Avenue to the eastern boundary of Pendleton Avenue; and exempting from said

prohibition non-commercial pickup trucks, emergency vehicles, including privately owned tow

trucks when providing emergency service to non-commercial vehicles, vehicles making

deliveries to nearby addresses, and vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) of ten-

7 thousand (10,000) pounds or greater; and containing an emergency clause.

## 8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:

9 **SECTION ONE.** <u>Definitions.</u> For purposes of this ordinance the terms set forth below are

"Commercial vehicle" means a vehicle which is licensed or designed or regularly used for the

transportation of freight, merchandise or property, other than non-commercial pickup trucks as

defined in Section 17.30.025 of the City's Revised Code of Ordinances, emergency vehicles,

including privately owned tow trucks when providing emergency service to non-commercial

vehicles, vehicles making deliveries to addresses near a restricted right-of-way, as such term is

defined in this Section One, and vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) of ten-thousand

(10,000) pounds or greater.

"Restricted right-of-way" means the public streets, alleys, and other public rights-of-way from

which commercial vehicles are prohibited by this ordinance.

commercial vehicle along CD Banks Avenue from the eastern boundary of North Newstead

3 Avenue to the eastern boundary of Pendleton Avenue.

4 **SECTION THREE.** Section Two of this ordinance shall not be construed as a prohibition

5 against any commercial vehicle which is traveling directly to a destination for loading,

unloading, or servicing, if there is no alternative route to said destination on streets and alleys

where commercial vehicle traffic is not prohibited.

8 **SECTION FOUR.** The Director of Streets is hereby directed to place signs notifying drivers of

the prohibition on commercial vehicles on restricted right-of-ways. Said signs shall be of a

conspicuous size and placed in a conspicuous location facing the flow of traffic at the

intersections where a restricted right-of-way begins. The notice on said signs shall include the

number of this ordinance, and shall be substantially in the following form:

**SECTION FIVE.** <u>Violations.</u> Persons violating this ordinance shall be guilty of an ordinance

violation, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500.00, or a term of imprisonment of not

more than ninety days, or both.

21 **SECTION SIX.** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public

22 peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning

- of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis, and therefore, this
- 2 ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
