1 An ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Streets to permanently close, barricade or
2 otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Vernon Avenue by blocking said traffic flow at the west
3 curb line of North Kingshighway Boulevard at the intersection of the Vernon Avenue and North
4 Kingshighway Boulevard.

5 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS:**

6 **SECTION ONE.** The Director of Streets is hereby authorized and directed to permanently close,
7 barricade or otherwise impede the flow of traffic on Vernon Avenue by blocking said traffic
8 flow at the east west curb line of North Kingshighway Boulevard at the intersection of the
9 Vernon Avenue and North Kingshighway Boulevard.

10 **SECTION TWO.** Emergency Clause. This being an ordinance for the preservation of public
11 peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning
12 of Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this
13 ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
