

BOARD BILL # 41 INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN LYDA KREWSON

1 An ordinance recommended and approved by the Airport Commission and the Board of
2 Estimate and Apportionment, authorizing and directing the Mayor and the Comptroller, on
3 behalf of the City of St. Louis (the "City"), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis
4 International Airport® (the "Airport"), to accept and execute on behalf of the City a certain
5 Airport Aid Agreement offered by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (the
6 "Grant Agreement") for the marketing and promotion of air service at the Airport for a
7 maximum obligation of Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Dollars (\$592,000) for the
8 reimbursement of direct costs associated with the projects funded under the Grant Agreement;
9 and containing an emergency clause.

10 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

11 **SECTION ONE.** The Mayor and the Comptroller, on behalf of the City of St. Louis (the
12 "City"), the owner and operator of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport® (the "Airport"), are
13 hereby authorized to accept and execute on behalf of the City an Airport Aid Agreement for
14 Project No. AIR 156-113C (the "Grant Agreement") offered by the Missouri Highways and
15 Transportation Commission (the "Highways Commission") substantially in the form attached
16 hereto as ATTACHMENT "1", which provides financial assistance to the City for the marketing
17 and promotion of air service at the Airport in accordance with the provisions of the Grant
18 Agreement (the "Project") which has been approved for state aviation trust fund participation in
19 the Highways Commission's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program, for a maximum
20 obligation of Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Dollars (\$592,000) for the reimbursement of
21 direct costs associated with the Project.

1 **SECTION TWO.** All terms, conditions, statements, warranties, representations,
2 covenants, agreements, and assurances contained in the Grant Agreement and the incorporated
3 materials referred to in the Grant Agreement are hereby ratified and approved and made a part
4 hereof.

5 **SECTION THREE.** ATTACHMENT “1” to this Ordinance is hereby incorporated
6 herein by this reference as if such attachment was duly set forth herein.

7 **SECTION FOUR.** This being an ordinance providing for public welfare, peace,
8 health, or safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as defined in Article IV,
9 Section 20 of the City Charter, and shall become effective immediately upon approval of the
10 Mayor of the City.
