

**BOARD BILL NO. 63    INTRODUCED BY: ALDERMAN BRANDON BOSLEY**

1            An ordinance directing the Director of Streets to make such changes in the present  
2 traffic pattern controlling traffic on Greer Ave., Dodier Ave., and University Ave. in the 3500  
3 block of said streets between N. Grand Blvd. and N. Garrison Ave so that as reconfigured the  
4 traffic pattern developed and in place as a result of the changes directed by this ordinance are  
5 as follows, namely: Greer - 3500 block - traffic to flow two-way between N. Grand Blvd. and  
6 N. Garrison Ave.; Dodier - 3500 block - traffic to flow two-way between N. Grand Blvd. and  
7 N. Garrison Ave.; University - 3500 block - traffic to flow one-way southeast between N.  
8 Grand Blvd. and N. Garrison Ave.

10 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS: SECTION ONE.**

12 **SECTION ONE.**     The Director of Streets is hereby authorized, empowered and directed  
13 to make such changes in the present traffic pattern controlling traffic on Greer Ave., Dodier  
14 Ave., and University Ave. in the 3500 block of said streets between N. Grand Blvd. and N.  
15 Garrison Ave so that as reconfigured the traffic pattern developed and in place as a result of  
16 the changes directed by this ordinance are as follows, namely:

18            Greer - 3500 block - traffic to flow two-way between N. Grand Blvd. and N. Garrison  
19 Ave.

21            Dodier - 3500 block - traffic to flow two-way between N. Grand Blvd. and N.  
22 Garrison Ave.

1 University - 3500 block - traffic to flow one-way southeast between N. Grand Blvd.  
2 and N. Garrison Ave.

4 **SECTION TWO.** This Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
5 public health, safety and general welfare, shall be and is hereby declared to be an emergency  
6 measure within the meaning of Article IV, Section 20, of the Charter of the City of St. Louis,  
7 and as such shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
