Steve Litman

WHEREAS, Steve Litman has booked and promoted many major concert attractions during his forty years as a concert promoter in venues ranging from 500 seat clubs to 60,000 seat stadiums and everything in between; and

WHEREAS, he was one of the original principals and Executive Vice President of Contemporary Productions, a major concert production company. He also served as president of that company's theatrical division, having presented live theatre and national touring companies from Boston to San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, in 1988 he left to start his own firm, Steve Litman Presents. For over 29 years, Steve Litman Presents has served as Executive Producer for all concert events at the historic Fox Theatre in St. Louis, one the nation's largest, most spectacular and successful theatres; and

WHEREAS, in addition, his concert presentation company, Steve Litman Presents, has promoted a wide range of concert events at venues across the United States and Canada including artists such as Jerry Seinfeld, Harry Connick, Jr., James Taylor, Ringo Starr, Diana Krall, David Bowie, Louis C.K., Tony Bennett, Luther Vandross and many more; and

WHEREAS, respected by his peers in the industry, he has been consistently recognized by professional associations such as the County Music Association and by industry trades as being among the top talent buyers and concert promoters in the country; and

WHEREAS, Steve has also been employed as a consultant on various live entertainment matters by companies including Anheuser Busch Companies, Qwest Communications, and Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital. He is in demand within the industry as a speaker, panelist, talent buyer and consultant; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize Steve Litman and wish him continued success and we further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
