HONORING SANDRA BOZICH-NELSON**

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of this Honorable Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis of the many accomplishments and achievements of Sandra Bozich-Nelson; and

WHEREAS, Sandra Bozich-Nelson, started with the City of St. Louis as an Administrative Assistant to the Hospital Administrator, Victoria Nelson, in 1977 at the old City Hospital; and

WHEREAS, later she became the Assistant to the Chief of Staff at the hospital, Dr. Kinsella; and

WHEREAS, upon the pending closure of the hospital Sandra went to the Health and Hospital Division at the St. Louis Health Department as an Administrative Assistant to Fred Wessels; and

WHEREAS, she transferred some years later to the St. Louis Lambert Field Airport and worked as the secretary to the Airport Director, Leanord Griggs; and

WHEREAS, after several years she was offered the position of Manager of Administrative Services for the St. Louis City Airport Police Division on September 10, 2001 where she has worked until the present day; and

WHEREAS, Sandra Bozich-Nelson has performed her duties for the City of St. Louis with the highest level of care and professionalism one could give; and

WHEREAS, she has admirably overseen her duties with the Airport Police during notable moments of crisis, such as the September 11th terrorist attacks and the tornado that struck in April of 2011; and

WHEREAS, after many years of faithful and professional service to the citizens of our community she has determined to retire with her last day of service being October 31, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by this Honorable Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize and congratulate Sandra Bozich-Nelson on her many achievements and contributions to the City of St. Louis and wish her the very, very best in her retirement.
