**HONORING FRANK CONDELLIRE ON HIS RETIREMENT**

**WHEREAS**, he attended St. James the Greater Catholic School in the City's Dogtown Neighborhood, and went on to attend Christian Brothers College High School where he graduated in 1977, after which he began working for United Exposition, a convention & trade show employer that set-up and dismantled conventions and tradeshow nationwide; and

**WHEREAS**, Frank quickly advanced within the company and in 1980, he became a Journeyman "A" Decorator with the Decorators & Displaymen Local 39; and

**WHEREAS**, Frank and his lovely wife Lori (Klipsch) were married at Seven Holy Founders Catholic Church, in St. Louis, Missouri, on February 21, 1981, and are blessed with four wonderful children, Amy, Frank, Anthony, and Angela, and five beautiful grandchildren; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 11, 1989, Frank was elected Vice President of the Decorators Union Local 39 Executive Board, and in January of 1994, Frank stepped up to become the Interim Business; Manager until he was officially elected Business Manager by the members of Local 39; and

**WHEREAS**, Frank ran unopposed as the Business Manager of the Decorators Union Local 39 and USW Local 25 until he retired on May 1, 2021, but he continues to work part-time to assist the new Business Manager; and

**WHEREAS**, Frank worked closely with the St. Louis Convention and Visitors Commission to bring events to St. Louis, and was awarded the Hospitality Labor Leader Award in 2007 and the Hospitality All Star Award in 2017; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by this Honorable Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize Frank Condellire for his many achievements and the contributions he has made to the St. Louis community.
