WHEREAS, he is the author of several books, he was the founder of Lil Saints Development Center and also founded West Flo Kitchen and Firehouse Studios; and

WHEREAS, he has traveled extensively throughout the world including Dubai, South America, South Africa, India, Kenya and Russia; and

WHEREAS, we honor and salute Bishop Coleman as he celebrates his 65th Birthday.
