

RESOLUTION 13
LIEUTENANT JOHN T. WALSH

WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis Board of Aldermen have been apprised that after thirty-five years of dedicated service to the City of St. Louis with the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department, Lieutenant John Walsh will retire after his final roll call on May 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, John Walsh was appointed to the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department on May 3, 1983, and has served with honor and distinction as a police officer, sergeant, and most as recently as Lieutenant; and

WHEREAS, throughout his distinguished career, Lieutenant Walsh has held various assignments with the Department, including service as an officer in the Fourth and Ninth Districts; and as a detective in the Fourth District in the Bureau of Crimes Against Persons Unit; and as a Sergeant in the First, Third, Seventh, and Eighth Districts; and

WHEREAS, during his career John also served in the following units: Homicide, Intelligence, Planning & Development, Human Resources, Internal Affairs, the Academy, Vice-Narcotics, Prisoner Processing, Crimes Against Property, Auxiliary Services, Communications, Mobile Reserve, Traffic Safety, and the Housing Authority Unit; and

WHEREAS, during that time, John received three Chief's Letter of Commendation and numerous letters of appreciation from grateful citizens; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 1993, he received a promotion to the rank of Sergeant and on April 12, 2006 he received a promotion to the rank of Lieutenant from the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department; his dedication and devotion to his family is attested by his wife, Dina, and his three children, Daniel, Tom and John.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to congratulate Lieutenant John T. Walsh for thirty-five years of commitment and loyalty to the citizens of the City of St. Louis and we wish him peace and happiness in his retirement and we further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
