

RESOLUTION NO. 34
Cellular Phones for the Public Administrator Guardianship Team

WHEREAS, Ordinance 68654 prohibits the possession or use of cellular telephones by any official or employee of the City of St. Louis except for those designated by resolution of the Board of Aldermen upon the recommendation of the Board of Estimate and Apportionment; and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2017, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment approved the request from the Public Administrator for one (1) cellular telephone to be shared by Guardianship Team of the Public Administrator's office; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Comptroller shall maintain all records generated by the use of any cellular telephone owned or leased by the City and, with the exception of the telephone number assigned to the city owned or leased cellular telephone, shall make such records available for public inspection upon reasonable notice to inspect; and

WHEREAS, the assignment and use of the cellular telephone is justified by the need to provide cost effective service to the citizens of the City of St. Louis.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we approve the assignment and use of a cellular telephone which is owned or leased by the City of St. Louis as provided by this Resolution. We direct the Clerk of this Board to provide a copy of this Resolution to the Office of the Comptroller.
