Dr. Alice Prince

WHEREAS, the Urban League of Metropolitan St. Louis, Inc. has selected 16 distinguished women to be honored at the *Salute to Women in Leadership Gala* celebrated on Friday, June 9, 2017, and held at the Marriott St. Louis Grand Hotel in downtown St. Louis, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the Urban League of Metropolitan St. Louis, Inc., under the leadership of its President and CEO, Michael McMillan, strives to enhance the lives of individuals within the entire Metropolitan area of St. Louis and St. Clair and Madison Counties in Illinois by focusing on self empowerment through 26 programs fostering education, economic and social services, neighborhood stabilization, and the recognition of outstanding women who have gone beyond the call of duty in service to the community; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Alice Prince is a recipient of the Salute to Women in Leadership Award; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Alice Prince is currently the Young Adult Workforce Division Manager at the St. Louis Agency on Training and Employment (SLATE) American Job Center in St. Louis, Missouri where her work in bettering the lives and the futures of young adults in the city goes unprecedented and unmatched; she currently oversees multiple contracts which all focus on youth employment, empowerment, mentoring, financial literacy, and legal services; her proudest accomplishment to date is the successful opening and launch of the nation's first and only 24 hour virtual high school in late December of 2016. The Workforce High School (in partnership with St. Louis Public Schools) aims to educate, inform, and meet the needs of its students 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Prince is a proud native of St. Louis, Missouri and a graduate of St. Louis University where she received her Bachelor of Science; she went on to Webster University in St. Louis, where she obtained a Master of Arts in Communication Management; Dr. Prince went on to receive a Doctorate in Educational Leadership and completed a groundbreaking study and research on the effects of student success and teacher-bullying; in her spare time, she can be found spending time with her husband Carlton and their daughter Taylor and twin boys Jalen and Kalen; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis owes its gratitude to the tireless efforts and lofty standards of leading women such as Dr. Alice Prince, recipient of the Salute to Women in Leadership Award for her career achievements, who has demonstrated a dedicated, altruistic commitment to her fellow citizens.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize Dr. Alice Prince as a Salute to Women in Leadership Award Honoree, and we wish our honoree continued success, achievement, and accomplishment.
