Pastor Donnie Moore

WHEREAS, Pastor Donnie has followed his chosen career path in the carpentry field and has worked as a Union carpenter for many years; he is known throughout the St. Louis region for his outstanding carpentry skills; he has served in the capacity of husband, father, grandfather, and other family roles, doing all of them very well; in his time spent outside of church he enjoys tinkering with model trains, collecting and using electronic gadgets, traveling, and spending time with his children and grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Donnie is truly a great man who has been anointed by God as a spiritual leader for his family and church; having been promoted to one of the most important roles in his life as a pastor in 2007, Pastor Donnie takes his charge very seriously; Pastor Donnie has always had a love for his parents and has used that love to continue the church, St. Samuel Temple; God has blessed Pastor Donnie and his wife to lead the church to new heights; because of his faithfulness, he has been elevated to the position of Assistant Superintendent for the Samuel Moore District.
