**Herzog School**

**WHEREAS**, Herzog Elementary School is a St. Louis Public school located at 5831 Pamplin, St. Louis, Missouri; and Ms. Sandra Bell serves as the Principal and Dr. Mendoza serves as the Assistant Principal; and Herzog School teaches children in preschool through fifth grade; under Ms. Bell's leadership, Herzog has reached full accreditation, meeting the guidelines of the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize, acknowledge, and congratulate the Herzog School on its gaining accreditation. We further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a memorial copy to the end that it may be presented to representatives of the Herzog School at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
