

**RESOLUTION 223**

**Intent to Seek Funding through the  
Community Development Block Grant Program**

**WHEREAS**, Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (“Title I”) states as its primary objective “the development of viable urban communities, by providing decent housing, suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities principally for persons of low and moderate income;”

**WHEREAS**, Title I offers to communities the opportunity of monetary assistance in accomplishing its aforementioned primary objective;

**WHEREAS**, the Missouri Department of Economic Development (“MoDED”) receives funds under Title I and is designated to award Community Development Block Grant funding under Title I to local governments within the State; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of St. Louis, Missouri has areas of need which may be addressed through funding from the Community Development Block Grant program; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is believed that improvements to the cobblestone streets in Laclede’s Landing, including First Street, Second Street, and Morgan Street, are eligible activities under Community Development Block Grant regulations;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the St. Louis Board of Aldermen as follows:

1. The City of St. Louis, Missouri (“the City”), is authorized to participate with the Missouri Department of Economic Development in the improvement of our community under the activities authorized pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.
2. The Mayor of the City of St. Louis, Missouri is hereby authorized to prepare and submit all documents which are necessary in applying for funding, and the Land Clearance for Redevelopment Authority of the City of St. Louis is designated as the organization to implement activities, including infrastructure improvements in the City’s central riverfront area, pursuant to Title I and the MODED Program.
3. The City, as applicant/sub-applicant, will dedicate \$0.00 (zero dollars and zero cents) of local cash funds and \$0.00 (zero dollars and zero cents) of in-kind materials or labor to be used in this project.
