WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. North Central Province includes Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin and Minnesota and was established in 1926. The Province Polemarch (President) is Korlon L. Kilpatrick, II; and

WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. was founded on the campus of Indiana University on January 5, 1911, the historically African-American fraternity's fundamental purpose is achievement in field of human endeavor. The fraternity has over 150,000 members with 721 undergraduate and alumni chapters in every state of the United States, and international chapters in the United Kingdom, Germany, Korea, Japan, United States Virgin Islands, Nigeria, and South America; and

WHEREAS, on April 16-19, 2015, the Middle Western Province (MWP) and North Central Province (NCP) will host its annual three-day business meeting in the city of St. Louis, Missouri. This year, the MWP Council and NCP Council will be held jointly at the St. Louis Union Station Hotel; and

WHEREAS, this will mark the 94th North Central Province Council.
