NOTICE TO VOTERS REQUESTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR THE MARCH 5, 2019 PRIMARY MUNICIPAL ELECTION

In the March 5, 2019 Primary Municipal Election, there is only ONE Republican Party candidate, who is running for Alderman in the 6th Ward. Unless you live in Ward 6, there is NO Republican Party ballot.

Although there is ONE Green Party candidate, who is running for President of the Board of Aldermen, he is the ONLY Green Party candidate and is running unopposed. Per Municipal Code Section 2.08.150, since there is only one Green Party candidate and the Green Party candidate for Governor in November, 2016, received less than 5% of the total votes cast for Governor, there is NO Green Party Ballot. Instead the one Green Party candidate will be declared and certified as the Green Party nominee for the office of President of the Board of Aldermen in the April 2, 2019 General Municipal Election.

There are NO other party candidates, and there are NO issues on the March 5, 2019 Primary Municipal Election ballot. Accordingly, unless you live in Ward 6, you MUST select a Democratic Party ballot if you want to vote in the March 5, 2019 Primary Municipal Election.
