ABSENTEE VOTING FOR AUGUST 4, 2020 PRIMARY ELECTION

ST. LOUIS CITY – Voters in the City of St. Louis who want to vote an absentee ballot for the **August 4, 2020 Primary Election** may do so at the Board of Election Commissioners, 300 N. Tucker Blvd., during the Board's regular office hours of 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. **The last day the Election Board can accept an absentee or mail-in ballot application by mail is Wednesday, July 22.** The last day to vote an absentee ballot in person is **Monday, August 3, at 5:00 P.M.**, the day before the Election.

Since **August 4** is a **Primary Election**, eligible city residents will have to select a Republican, Democratic, Libertarian, Green or Constitution Party ballot **OR** a **Non-Partisan** (issues only) ballot in order to vote.

Eligible voters should receive a Notice of Election card in the mail informing them of the **August 4, 2020 Primary Election** and the name and address of their polling location. Voters are encouraged to bring their Notice of Election card with them on **August 4**, as it is an acceptable form of ID and will facilitate the check-in process. **A photo ID is NOT required.**
