ABSENTEE VOTING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC SATURDAY, APRIL 3, 2021

ST. LOUIS CITY – Voters in the City of St. Louis who want to vote an absentee ballot for the **April 6, 2021, General Municipal Election** may do so at the Board of Election Commissioners, 300 N. Tucker Blvd., on Saturday, **April 3, from 9:00 A.M. until 1:00 P.M.** This is in addition to the Board's regular office hours of 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday. The last day the Election Board could accept an absentee ballot application by mail was **Wednesday, March 24**. The last day to vote an absentee ballot in person is **Monday, April 5, at 5:00 P.M.**, the day before the Election.

Although **April 6** is a **General Election**, due to the passage of Proposition D last November all candidates on the ballot are **Non-Partisan** candidates. There are **NO** party designations on the ballot. Voters may only vote for one candidate for each office, except for candidates for the Board of Education, where voters can vote for three candidates. There are also several propositions on the ballot, including a proposition to extend the city earnings tax for an additional five years, an MSD bond issue, and five MSD charter amendment propositions.

Eligible voters should have received a Notice of Election card in the mail informing them of the **April 6, 2021, General Municipal Election** and the name and address of their polling location. Voters are encouraged to bring their Notice of Election card with them on **April 6**, as it is an acceptable form of ID and will facilitate the check-in process. **A photo ID is NOT required.**
