ABSENTEE VOTING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

ST. LOUIS CITY – Voters in the City of St. Louis who want to vote an absentee ballot for the **November 7 Special Election** may do so at the Board of Election Commissioners, 300 N. Tucker Blvd., during regular office hours of 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. In addition, the Election Board will be open to the public on **Saturday, November 4, from 9:00 A.M. until 1:00 P.M.** The last day the Election Board can accept an absentee ballot application by mail is **Wednesday, November 1**. The last day to vote an absentee ballot in person is **Monday, November 6, at 5:00 P.M.**, the day before the Election.

Since this is a **Special Election**, voters do not have to select a party ballot, as everyone votes the same ballot. All registered voters will be voting on Proposition P, a proposed sales tax increase, and registered voters in Ward 2 will also have the opportunity to vote on candidates for Alderman to fill the unexpired term of the previous Alderman who resigned.

Notice of Election cards were mailed to registered voters last week. Voters are encouraged to review their Notice of Election card closely to be sure they go to the correct polling place to cast their ballot.

Although the new Photo ID law is now in effect, and voters are encouraged to bring a photo ID with them to their polling place on November 7, **every registered voter will be able to vote on November 7 even if they do not have a photo ID with them on that day.**
