## CITY ELECTION BOARD SETS DATE FOR SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL WARD 8 VACANCY

**(St. Louis, MO)** The City Election Board will hold a Special Election in Ward 8 on Tuesday, February 13, 2018, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Alderman Stephen Conway on November 27, 2017. Because the vacancy occurs more than 180 days prior to the next General Municipal Election in 2019, Article IV, Section 5 of the City Charter requires that a Special Election be held no sooner than 75 days nor later than 90 days after the occurrence of the vacancy. The individual elected will serve for the remainder of Alderman Conway's unexpired term.

Since there is no primary election in this instance, the city central committees of the established political parties have the right to certify to the Election Board their candidate to stand for election to fill the vacancy no later than 30 days before the date of the Special Election. Since that date (Jan. 14) falls on a Sunday, the deadline is the close of business on Friday, January 12. A nonpartisan/independent candidate has until that same deadline to submit a petition containing the signatures of at least 10% of the registered voters in Ward 8 who voted in the April 4, 2017 mayoral election (i.e., 325 signatures). Absentee voting for the February 13 Ward 8 Special Election will begin on Tuesday, January 16.
