FILING OPENS FOR BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBERS

ST. LOUIS CITY – Individuals in the City of St. Louis who desire to file to be a candidate for Member of the Board of Education of the City of St. Louis in the **April 6, 2021 General Municipal Election** may do so at the Office of the Board of Election Commissioners, 300 N. Tucker Blvd., starting Tuesday, December 15, and ending on Tuesday, January 19, 2021, during regular office hours of 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. To qualify, a candidate must be at least 24 years of age; a citizen and resident of the City for at least three years immediately preceding their election; and shall not hold any office, except that of notary public, in the city or state, nor be interested in any contract with or claim against the Board of Education.

At the time of filing, a candidate is required to pay a filing fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and provide a Clearance Form from the Collector of Revenue evidencing that he/she is not delinquent in the filing or payment of any personal property tax, real property tax on properties located in the City of St. Louis that are wholly or partially owned by the candidate, and City of St. Louis earnings tax; and that the candidate is not delinquent in the payment of City of St. Louis water and refuse bills.

There are three positions on the Board of Education that are up for election on April 6. Members elected will serve four (4)-year terms.
