

DO YOU WANT TO VOTE BY MAIL (EITHER BY ABSENTEE OR VOTE BY MAIL)?

Are you at risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19 (ex. 65 or older)?

Are you confined due to illness/disability on Election Day or care for someone who is?

Do you expect to be absent from St. Louis City on Election Day?

Are you a poll worker at a location other than your assigned polling place on Election Day?

Does your religious belief or practice prevent you from voting on Election Day?

Are you incarcerated, but otherwise eligible and have registered to vote?

Are you a certified participant in an address-protection program?

Do you **NOT** have a "reason" for wanting to vote by mail, but would prefer to rather than going to a polling place?

If so...

Complete an application for an **ABSENTEE BALLOT**. A printable form can be found on the Election Board website, or obtained by contacting the Election Board.

Submit the application to the Election Board in person, by mail (300 N. Tucker, St. Louis, MO, 63101), fax (314 622 3378), or email (stlcityabsentee@stlouis-mo.gov) as soon as possible. **THE DEADLINE FOR REQUESTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL IS OCTOBER 21ST!**

Once you receive your ballot, complete it as soon as you receive it. Your ballot **DOES NOT NEED TO BE NOTARIZED**

Mail or hand deliver your ballot to the Board of Election (300 N. Tucker, St. Louis, MO 63101). The Board of Election must have your ballot by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. If using U.S. Mail, mail your ballot at least 10 days in advance of November 3rd.

If so...

Complete an application for an **ABSENTEE BALLOT**. A printable form can be found on the Elections Board website, or obtained by contacting the Elections Board.

Submit the application to the Election Board in person, by mail (300 N. Tucker, St. Louis, MO, 63101), fax (314 622 3378), or email (stlcityabsentee@stlouis-mo.gov) as soon as possible. **THE DEADLINE FOR REQUESTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL IS OCTOBER 21ST!**

Once you receive your ballot, complete it as soon as you receive it. Your ballot envelope **MUST BE NOTARIZED**

YOU MUST MAIL YOUR BALLOT (300 N. TUCKER, ST. LOUIS, MO 63101). YOU CANNOT HAND DELIVER YOUR BALLOT TO THE ELECTION BOARD. The Election Board must have your ballot by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. If using U.S. Mail, mail your ballot at least 10 days in advance of November 3rd.

TRACK YOUR BALLOT USING THE INSTRUCTION SHEET THAT COMES WITH YOUR BALLOT AND MAKE SURE THE BALLOT IS RECEIVED BY THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS.

If so...

Complete an application for an **VOTE BY-MAIL BALLOT**. A printable form can be found on the Elections Board website or obtained by contacting the Election Board.

Submit the application to the Election Board in person or by mail (300 N. Tucker, St. Louis, MO 63101). **THE DEADLINE FOR REQUESTING AN MAIL-IN BALLOT IS OCTOBER 21ST!** (Your ballot can be surrendered at your correct polling location and you will be able to cast a ballot in person.)

Once you receive your ballot, complete it as soon as you receive it. Your ballot envelope **MUST BE NOTARIZED**
