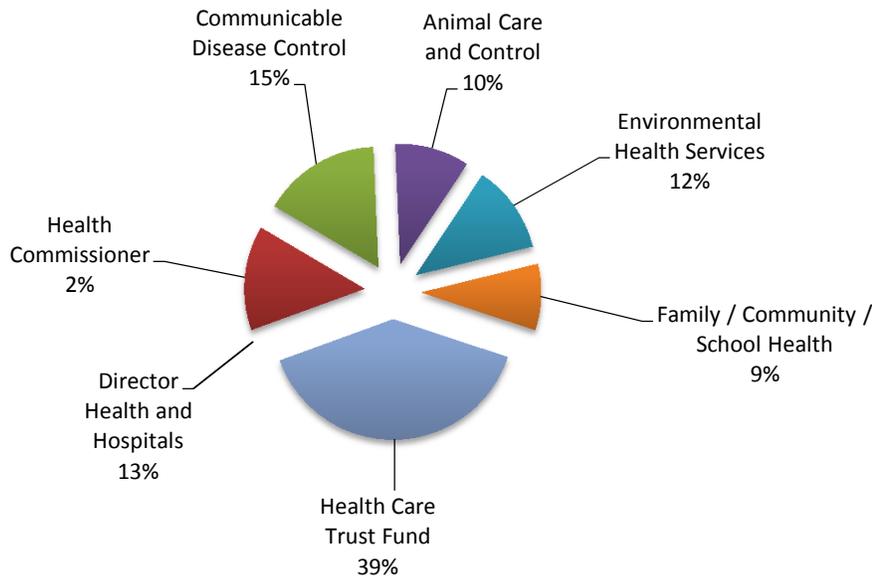

FY17 LOCAL USE TAX FUND BUDGET BY DIVISION



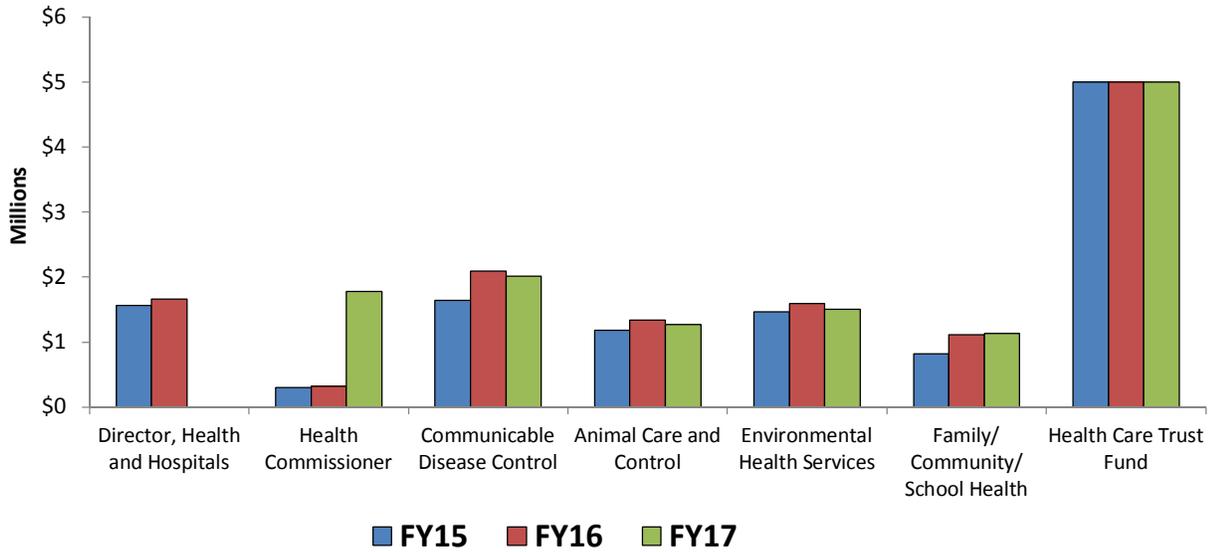

DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

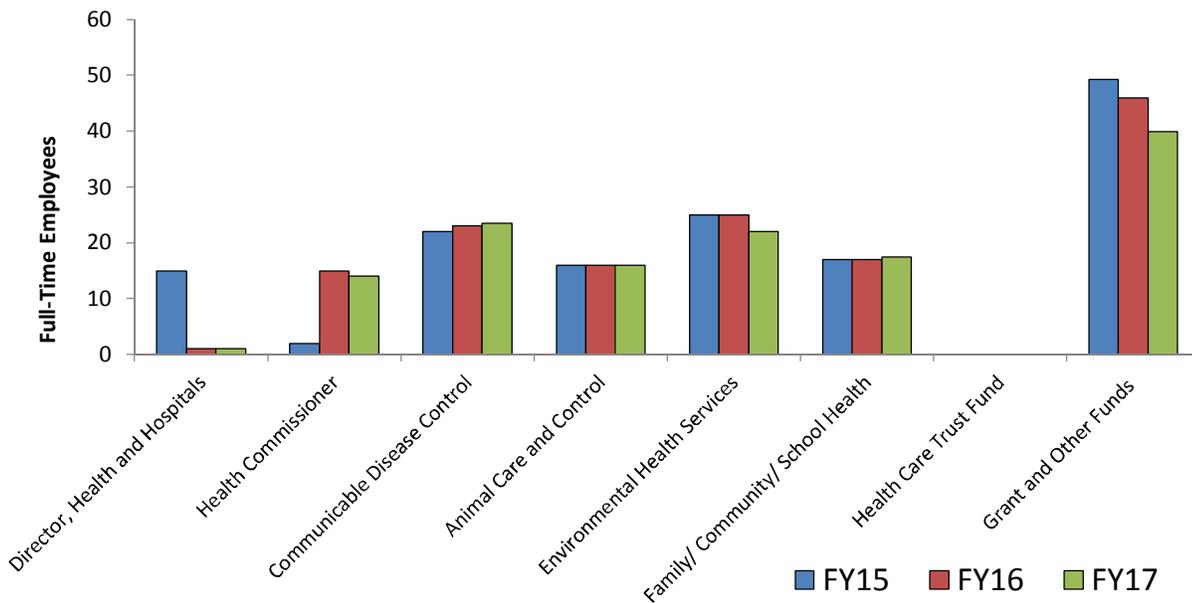
- As part of the Let's Move! STL 6th anniversary celebration, the DOH partnered with daycare centers to teach kids about health and wellness.

LOCAL USE TAX BUDGET HISTORY BY DIVISION



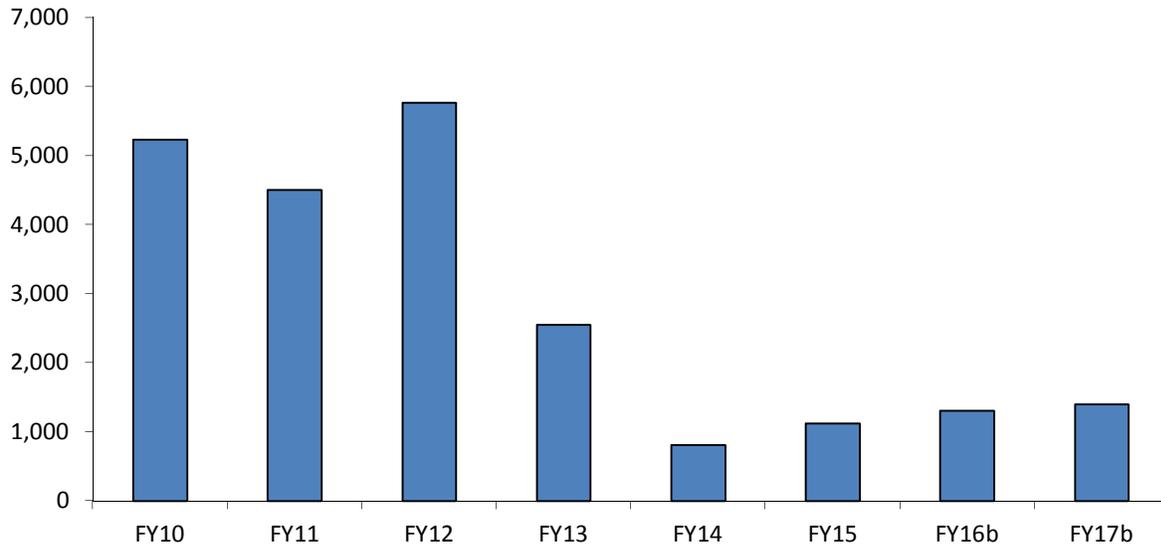
LOCAL USE TAX PERSONNEL HISTORY BY DIVISION



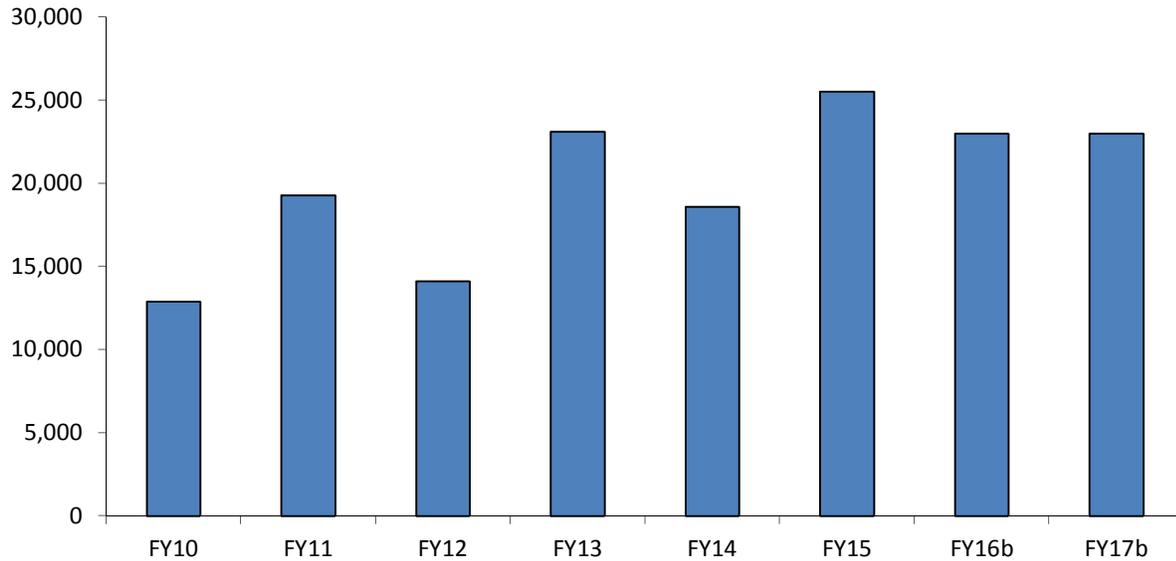

HIV Tests Performed



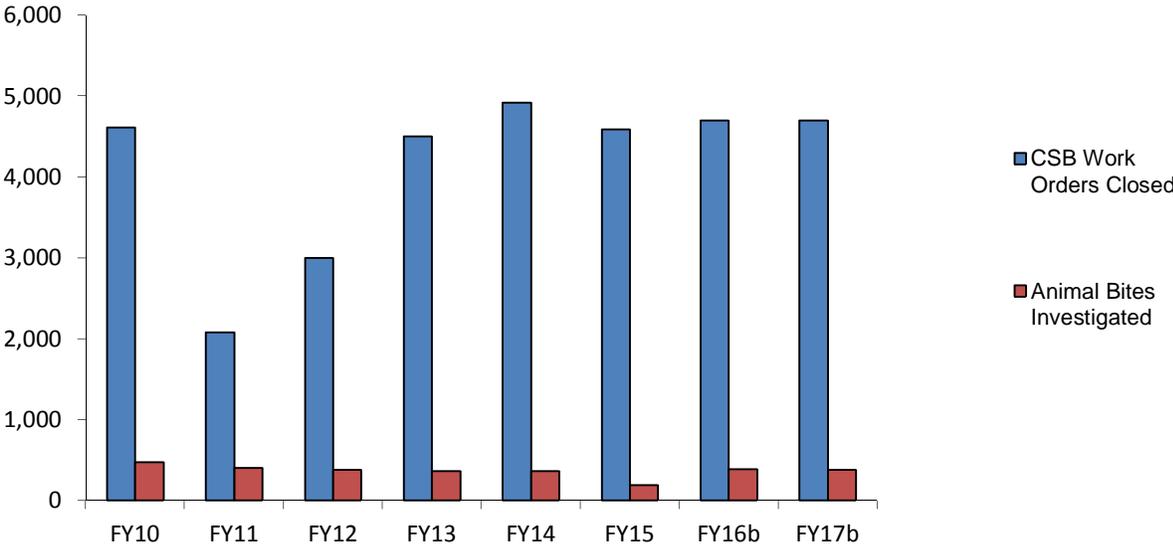
Immunization Compliance Audits



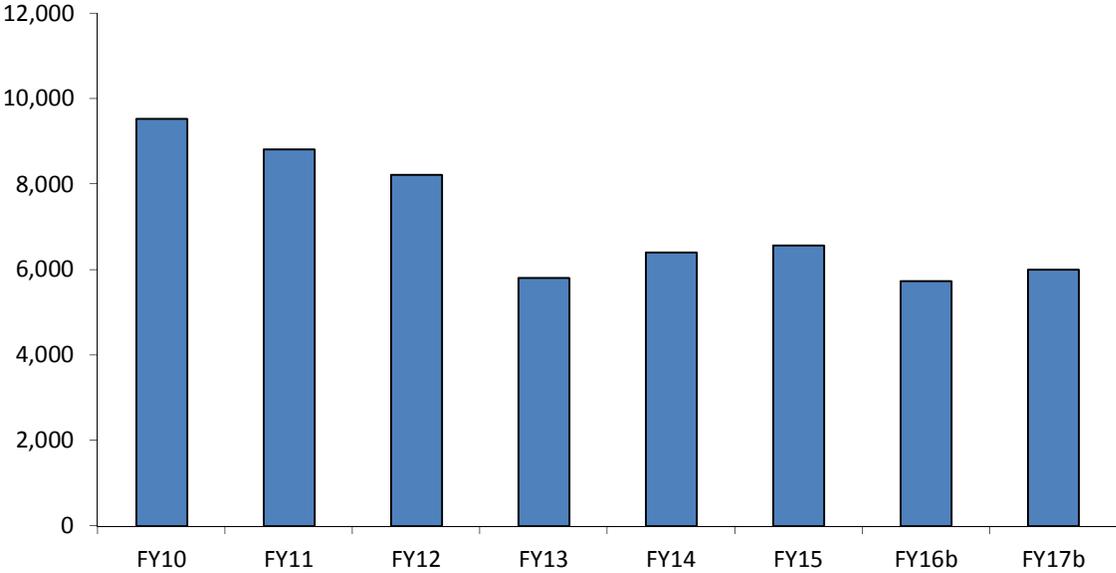

PROGRAM NOTES

During FY16 most of the positions and responsibilities of the Director of Health and Hospitals were transferred to the Health Commissioner's Office (Dept. 710) and the budget for FY17 reflects this arrangement. The FY17 budget for the Director's Office contains an appropriation for an existing grant and the authorization of the position of Director of Health and Hospitals which remains vacant.

PROGRAM NOTES

In FY16, most of the positions and responsibilities of the Director of Health and Hospitals were transferred to the Commissioner's Office. This will continue in FY17 and beyond.

MISSION & SERVICES

Communicable Disease Control (CDC) is dedicated to providing effective monitoring, protection, prevention, and promotion of public health to the citizens of St. Louis with regards to communicable diseases.

Services provided by Communicable Disease Control include, but are not limited to: counseling and testing, HIV and hepatitis surveillance, disease intervention services, community planning, TB control, HIV/AIDS care services and medical records.

PROGRAM NOTES

In FY16, CDC developed a RFP for a physician in the TB clinic and restructured the medical case management of the Ryan White Case Management System. In FY17, CDC will restructure and reconvene the clinical quality management workgroups for navigating clients through the care continuum. CDC will also restructure Early Intervention Services.

MISSION & SERVICES

The mission of Animal Care and Control and Vector Control is to ensure the health and safety of City of St. Louis residents and companion animals through the enforcement of pet-related ordinances as well as the promotion of pet safety and responsible pet ownership. Animal Care and Control is dedicated to providing an array of animal control, health and pet-owner services to promote responsible pet ownership and humane treatment of animals among the citizens of St. Louis and to protect citizens against insect and animal borne diseases.

PROGRAM NOTES

In FY16 officers were equipped with tablet computers and an integrated pest management outreach program was implemented in collaboration with Community Sanitation. In FY17 staff will be equipped and trained to collect and identify mosquito types for surveillance of disease-carrying species. Animal Control will continue its partnership with Stray Rescue and Animal House for the adoption of stray animals and the reduction of euthanasia rates in the City.

MISSION & SERVICES

Environmental Health Services (EHS) strives to ensure the citizens of St. Louis have a safe and sanitary environment. The division protects public health by improving the City's air quality. In addition, the division inspects food service establishments, childcare facilities, lodging facilities, and swimming pools. Inspectors also respond to citizen complaints and enforce codes.

PROGRAM NOTES

In FY16, new sound detection equipment was purchased and noise complaint protocols were developed. In addition, access was provided for free water sample analysis. In FY17, Environmental Health will incorporate all Community Sanitation inspection types into Health Space and will revise the air pollution control ordinance to incorporate those duties.

Family/ Community/ School Health (FCH) works toward reaching the highest risk populations for contracting chronic and communicable diseases including youth, refugee, immigrant, and incarcerated populations in an effort to help them get the care they need.

Division services include, but are not limited to: school health screenings and referrals, immunization audits, community outreach, health and wellness education, infant mortality initiatives and other prenatal care services.

PROGRAM NOTES

In FY16, FCH taught healthy eating habits to more than 55 children as part of a plan to reduce obesity in the City's children. In FY17 FCH will complete a major cardiovascular outreach event with the St. Louis chapter of the American Heart Association.
