The Public Hearing was called to order at 10:07 a.m.

**Mayor Lyda Krewson:**

This meeting is being held in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance 49318 approved March 2, 1959, which states in part "...The Board of Estimate and Apportionment shall review the proposed budget with the heads of departments and other agencies and hold at least one public hearing thereon, after giving at least five (5) days' notice in the City Journal..." The required notice was published in the St. Louis City Journal on Tuesday, April 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> and in the St. Louis Post Dispatch on Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

**DURING THE PUBLIC HEARING:**

The Mayor briefly explained the budget process, outlined some new items and changes from past years and announced that this meeting is designed to hear citizens' comments by offering an opportunity for speakers to sign up.

The President of the Board of Aldermen thanked citizens for their attendance and offered explanation of other opportunities for future engagement and participation from the public.

The Comptroller offered thanks to the citizens for attendance and welcomed their comments.

The Mayor thanked Citizens for their attendance and comments.


