

**RESOLUTION
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE FIREFIGHTERS' RETIREMENT PLAN
OF THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.19.140 of Ordinance 69245, as amended by Ordinances 69353 and 70248, it is the duty of Board of Trustees to interpret and decide all questions concerning Plan provisions;

WHEREAS, in administering benefits of the Plan, a question of interpretation regarding Sections 4.19.050(C) has been presented to the Board of Trustees, specifically whether such Subsection of the Plan applies to Grandfathered Participants;

WHEREAS, Section 4.19.050(C) states that each Participant who remains an Employee until the Participant has completed at least ten (10) but fewer than twenty (20) Years of Service shall be entitled to a monthly retirement income (calculated as for normal retirement in accordance with Section 4.19.050(A), based on the Participant's Average Final Earnings and Years of Service as of Termination of Employment) payable for the Participant's lifetime beginning at age 62, or upon Termination of Employment if later; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.19.020(V) of the Plan defines "Participant" to include those Firefighters employed on or after the Effective Date of the Plan, as well as those Firefighters employed before the Effective Date of the Plan.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Firefighters' Retirement Plan of the City of St. Louis:

1. Section 4.19.050(C) applies to all Participants of the Plan, including Grandfathered Participants.
