Dear DANA KELLY:

I have been advised that the business that you operate located at 1122 Washington Avenue, St. Louis, MO 63101, a place of private or public assembly, has been the site of continued violations of my order Number 8, requiring social distancing, and my Order Number 11, requiring the wearing of facial coverings. The observation of these orders is essential to protect the public health. Accordingly, and pursuant to 19 CSR 20.20.050 (c), I order that your premise located at 1122 Washington Avenue, St. Louis, MO 63101, shall be closed effective immediately, and shall not be reopened before December 15, 2021, unless and until I order otherwise.

Due to evidence from the weekend of December 12, 2020, immediate closure is imperative to protect public health. The premise located at 1122 Washington Avenue, St. Louis, MO 63101, shall be closed for all public purposes, regardless of whether the event is under Reign's direct control or is being sponsored by a third party.

The premise located at 1122 Washington Avenue, St. Louis, MO 63101, shall only be permitted to open sooner when all of the following conditions are met.

- The COVID-19 percent positivity rate for the City of St. Louis is at or below 5% for at least 30 days.
- The COVID-19 vaccine becomes available for the general population and the City achieves herd immunity (>90% of the population has been vaccinated for COVID-19).
- The pandemic has been declared over by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
