1. Facility shall provide yearly training for source operators.
2. Facility shall keep accurate monthly records of solvent types, amounts purchased and solvent consumption for each listed source, for a minimum of five (5) years.
3. The responsible official for this facility shall not allow the operation of any cold cleaner using a solvent with a vapor pressure greater than 1.0 millimeters of mercury (mmHg) at 68 degrees Fahrenheit unless the cold cleaner is used for carburetor cleaning or spray gun cleaning.
4. Facility shall keep this permit on-site (on or near the unit(s)) for the life of the unit(s).
