Withdrawal and Removal of Membership

A member may withdraw from the CoC at any time by submitting a letter of withdrawal to the membership committee and presented to the Board of Directors.

Any member may be removed from the CoC by a vote of a two-thirds majority of the Board of Directors. Removal is effective only if it occurs at a meeting called for that purpose. Removal requests will be submitted to the Governance and Membership committee and then presented to the Board of Directors. A representative of the organization or individual recommended for removal shall have the opportunity to speak on their behalf prior to a vote of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may deliberate without the representative of the member recommended for removal present prior to the vote of the Board of Directors.

CoC members must exercise care when acting on behalf of the CoC. Repeated failure to participate thoughtfully and respectfully in discussions or persistent disruptive or obstructive conduct during meetings will be grounds for removal. Failure to act in accordance with the mission or expectations of the CoC, or failure to act in a positive and respectful manner will also be grounds for removal.
