**4-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be reduced and include the date the project applicant was notified of the reduction. (limit 750 characters)**

The YWCA RRH DV project scored 5th lowest among all renewal projects. Ranking 24 of the 26 projects in Tier 1, it was the only project large enough to support a 23% reduction and still provide at least \$1 million specifically for RRH DV. The decision to re-allocate funding from the YWCA project enabled the CoC to add a 2nd high scoring new project into Tier 1 that would achieve two things: 1) any RRH DV beds lost as a result of the 23% reduction to the YWCA project would not reduce the number of RRH beds overall; and 2) the new DOORWAYS project would further diversify the types of available housing options with the addition of TH-RRH. The YWCA was notified of the funding reduction and re-allocation in writing November 1, 2021.
