

FY2019 EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)
Questions and Answers

1. On page 5, in the Project Description, Scope and Relevance section: The instructions says that the narrative should include a statement of priorities, is this the medical statement of priorities as in the charting process that show how we will do the work? What is meant by that term?
 - a. For a Statement of Priorities, please address your agency's priorities with use of the requested funds. This should include what outcomes you perceive for the requested funds. The City is looking for narrative addressing why your agency should be awarded funding and how homelessness will be addressed with use of these funds.

2. Page 5: With Rapid Rehousing dollars, do we have to support the general community or can those funds be used specifically for the youth who reside in shelter
 - a. With HUD funds use and compliance with Coordinated Entry is mandatory. This means that all ESG funds for Rapid Rehousing must take referrals from Coordinated Entry. You may write your RRH program specific to housing youth, however you have to house youth that are referred to your RRH program through Coordinated Entry. Sometimes a referral may be a youth that happens to be residing in your shelter, but other times it may be a youth referred from other locations. Regardless of where the youth resides, if a referral is made you will be required to work with that youth being referred to the RRH program.

3. Page 4: Emergency Shelter dollars, if pursuing renovation cost will those funds only cover sleeping quarters are can it assist with other areas in the shelter that ties back into one of the areas of support outlined by the funding... such employment and education or mental health spaces?
 - a. Answer forthcoming. I am looking more into this question.

4. Page 12: Of the seven copies that have been requested should that be a full packet both project proposal and required attachments
 - a. Yes, we are requiring seven (7) copies of the entire packet to include attachments.
