

Knowing the most important thing needed is obviously the drainage problems we have, which I understand are the top priority of this plan, I would like for you to re-think the plan for a permanent soccer field.

As a high school soccer ref and big fan of the game, if a permanent field is installed, I am worried that it would be taken over on weekends by those who also enjoy the game, the Bosnian population. I have seen the crowds of players and fans gather at Mallinckrodt School, (Hampton & Pernod) on weekends and I feel they would love the chance to move from there to a nicer field that is bigger than the one they're at now.

My main worry is the amount of traffic along the streets surrounding Francis and the speeds I see some of these kids in their cars go (Wilmore Park) and the noise coming out of them. Also, no restrooms close enough for them. I have heard of rumors of complaints from residents behind the field, of fans and players urinating along the fences and trees. Plus trash left behind.

Eliminate the problem before it begins. Leave the softball field where it is and add the other you have in your plan, or move the field at the other end back so it is safe for two teams to compete. Remember what happened to the basketball nets at Wilmore park that were next to the playground? After enough complaints from the visitors, the baskets were removed and it became a pleasant place to go for adults with their kids.

Lastly, soccer is a sport that has been taken over by select teams. There are enough permanent fields for teams to go to, besides, the only time I see kids playing soccer in the neighborhood is with their Parish teams, which is a couple of months in the fall. Also, the CYC is planning to make two fields out of the one they have at the Magdalen Center on Kingshighway they own. Plenty of chances for teams to go there.

Dear Ms. Coyne:

I had to leave the meeting early this evening to get to two (2) St. Gabriel Playoff Basketball games. I talked to the gentleman that made the presentation just prior to leaving, and he asked me to leave my phone number, which I did, to volunteer my help. I could NOT hear or see much of the presentation, because my hearing aids were in for repair, and actually couldn't read much of the pictures presented, therefore requested a copy of the "Francis Park Strategic Plan", so I can thoroughly study it up close. He said, I could get one from a web site, that would go on line tomorrow. What is the web site???

Attached are some recommendations that I made previously.

Also, a few additional thoughts: 1st, this is a Neighborhood Park, near three (3) schools, therefore like all Neighborhood Parks its main emphasis should be "Youth Oriented". Being near three (3) schools should make it "More Youth Oriented". At least, that is what I was taught, during my BS, MA and PhD, and the many texts we utilized during my Professional Career, teaching many Rec Leadership Majors Course at SLCC at Forest Park. As Department Chair, it was responsibility to hire Professionals to teach the additional courses, over and above my allotted (15 Credit Hours) teaching time, per semester. I would then hire local Professional experts, with years of experience, to teach the Overload. We used the latter, as our Department Advisory Committee. They would also

help place our Students on their three (3) OJT Rec field experience courses. The latter were required by the State for their AA Degree of 120 hours each, which were titled Coop I, II, & III. During the latter, they were also required as a team of two or three students, to Evaluate local Parks and Rec Centers. Many of the recommendations below, were from their Evaluations, which were National Survey Forms.

To date my two biggest concerns are: 1st, Why we have not used the HIGH Ground Across from Nottingham School, which has tremendous Natural Drainage for additional Multi-Purpose courts and athletic fields. We could do the same across from both St.Gabriel and Word of Life Schools, saving many man-hours for coaches, teachers and students. In addition, it would be much "safer" and easier to supervise, to and from the three (3) schools. 2nd, The so-called "Valley Area", should be used for more Multi-Purpose fields and courts, for small-sided, lead-up games and practice. This area has had drainage problems, and at times after some hard rains, looks like a small lake. Therefore, we would need additional "Drainage" improvements, which I believed the presentor addressed somewhat, earlier this evening.

As I sat in the Word of Life gym, I noted State Lutheran championship banners, in Basketball, Volleyball and Soccer. I also, thought of the Championship banners at St. Gabriel in those sports plus softball and baseball. And having coached in the area for nearly forty (40) years, and another twenty-two (22) years in Northwest St.Louis City and County, we have discussed the limited available facilities with many of my former players, parents and students. In addition, many of these facilities like our present B.J. Lenoard Field at Francis are in extremely poor and hazardous conduction. Case in point, today prior to going to the Word of Life Meeting, I stopped by the latter, and it looked like its usual "Swampy Condition", after a "relatively light rain", earlier today.

Many of the individuals, I mentioned above that I worked with and coached have moved into our area. We have discussed the

conditions many times, and I am certain they would agree that we MUST do better for our children and grandchildren.

I realize that these two emails are rather lengthy, however this is a tremendously important topic to our family, neighbors and above all the Youth of the Area. We would like to see things BETTER for our grandchildren, than they were for us, my five children and seven step children, that were all graduates of St. Gabriels.

Thanking you in advance for your help, and please remember as I mentioned previously, I am retired and am "volunteering", my time and years of experience to see this project through to its completion.

By the way, I noted in some of your recommendations earlier this evening, that many of items we previously recommended were included in your presentation.

Dear Donna:

As previously mentioned to you early this evening and previously, I am emailing you, RECOMMENDATIONS by those listed in the subject above.

I had previously mentioned a few of these to you, a few years back, as you should recall.

We cannot make the Meeting at DuBourg H.S, because of prior scheduled responsibilities. Therefore, please submitted these for us:

1st..Install "Multi-purpose regulation" baseball, softball and soccer fields on the "High Ground", at the corner of Donovan & Nottingham, excluding the TREES,

Shrubs and landscaped areas, near the sidewalks. These would be across from Nottingham School, going EAST to approximately Delor Street. This area would have "Excellent Drainage", compared to the present B.J. Leonard Field, which the "Old-timers" in the area tell me, was where a "Spring-fed Creek", once ran. They claim, it was put underground in pipes, and covered. If the latter statements are true, it explains why those fields have been historically "Swampy and Extremely Dangerous", throughout the years, with just a little rain or snow.

2nd..The latter area (BJ Leonard) should be CROWNED, with Multi-purpose turf or soft surface (which would help the knees and legs), and made into Small-sided Courts. EXAMPLES, 3 VS 3 basketball, 6 VS 6 Soccer, Batting Cages, exterior track, etc (next to or also around the tennis courts). The latter could be covered by a large shelter, therefore available for use during wet weather, and much safer for our citizens.

3rd..The "So-called Valley Area" and Corner across from St. Gabriel Church (corner of Tamm & Nottingham, again east to approximately Delor), could become another Multi-purpose area for: Sand Volleyball, small-sided soccer, Indian ball, SMALL T-ball, softball, cork and swiffle-ball backstops at the base of the Hill, which could be removed for the winter sled riders.

4th..Expansion of the Playground area, with additional swings, slides and other Fun-n-fitness youth equipment, as large or larger than the neighboring parks (Note what Wilmore, Lindenwood and Tilles, has compared to us).

5th..A 5K, figure Eight (8) running trail "Centrally" located, throughout the Park, approximately 4 to 8 feet wide, with a soft multi-purpose, "all weather" surface. At present, the runners & walkers who are concerned about their KNEES & LEGS well-being, like most "knowlegdeable runners", have made their own trail just inside the exterior sidewalk, rather than utilize the "Hard-Dangerous Sidewalk", around the Park. The latter would not only be tremendously welcomed by the present walkers/runners, but by the "Girls/Boys on the Run", from local schools. As you may know, "Girls on the Run" has been an after-school program at St.Gabriels these past few years.

As you read this, I am certain your are saying, as you told me previously, "What about the Green-space"??? Our answers are: 1st, The "Entire exterior" of the Park, both outside & inside the Side-Walk would remain as is---trees, grass, shrubs, flower beds, etc.

2nd, We would still have all the "Interior Green-Space", additional landscaping around and throughout the recommended trails, shelter and multi-purpose courts/fields. Approximately 70 to 80% or more of the Present "Green-Space" would remain. I maybe able to get FREE consultation from my son, nephew and niece who are in Nursery/Landscaping Businesses. In fact, the latter own one of the largest such companies in the Greater St.Louis Area. They maybe willing and definitely able to improve the "Lillie Pond Area", since Ponds Lighting and Waterfalls are specialty areas for their company.

3rd, What is more important, our "childrens health and well-being" in a SAFER Park or "Green Space"????

As mentioned in the subject, these recommendations are from present Area Youth, Rec Leadership majors from the Mid-70's and Professionals, that made many of these recommendations back then, to the City Recreation Department, when I was Director of Recreational & Park Leadership for SLCC (Forest Park).

In addition, we maybe able to get "Federal Money" over and above what is now available, like Dick Gephardt did for the newly built facility at Carondelet Park. As I recall, he secured the money for the latter over ten (10) years ago, because I was invited to the announcement meeting.

I am available to "Volunteer" on these improvements, "Free of Charge", and could probably get other Retired Professionals, like myself to help.

Donna: Hi. I don't know if I missed a meeting about the topic of addressing the water drainage, or lack of drainage issues from the ball field areas at Francis Park. I have a few thoughts if I may offer them.

1. My family moved to the 6200 block of Walsh when I was 5 years old. I was never home, always out playing and I am quite certain I was in Francis Park almost every day. As long as I can remember, that area has "flooded". Winter (ice covered) spring, fall, summer, no matter. We swam many times in a hole that is now filled just northeast of the playground area.
2. The ball field area is the lowest point in a park that is the lowest point in the area. That is why a creek runs near it from the north side of the tennis courts. It is even lower than the lily pond.
3. Why not work with nature instead of fighting it? That wet area of the park would make a great garden area with plants that thrive in such a soaked type of landscape. Work with the Missouri Botanical garden or other knowledgeable group to create a spectacular, lush environment that would be very low maintenance and highly sustainable.
4. The current ball field configuration leaves much to be desired. The fields are too close to each other. The north field is too close to the tennis courts. The soccer fields are always impacted by the muddy or dried mud with hard divot covered softball infields. I think the great Bernie Leonard would agree that there are better places for the field named in his honor. Move the ball fields and soccer field to higher ground, such as the area in front of St. Gabriel's church for soccer, and the area below the sledding hill on Tamm Ave for softball. The area near the corner of Tamm and Eichelberger could contain a field. These could be developed at much less cost than engineering an entire drainage system to move water from where it naturally needs to flow.

Francis Park is treasure that should last forever. A fantastic garden area that naturally grows in what is really a blessing of abundant water rather than a problem would add visual beauty, attract songbirds and provide shade. It could even be

partially utilized for a Public vegetable garden like the ones growing in other parts of the city, thus returning part of Mr. Francis' farm to production of food. Wouldn't it be great to include a small kiosk for the sale of park grown produce in Art in the Park?

I hope you will offer my thoughts to your constituents.

As you may know, the SLHNA History Committee has been very active recently on a number of different fronts, one of which is our attempts to find a neutral, permanent home for the historical artifacts we are collecting. (As examples, Ann Layton has recently donated four originals of News of St. Louis Hills from 1945 to 1952. Also, Mitch has located two DVDs of interviews that were conducted with noteworthy residents of St. Louis Hills.)

The Committee has encountered significant difficulty in getting a few residents who hold a significant amount of historical artifacts to surrender them to the Association. We think that if the Committee could locate a neutral site (as opposed to someone's basement), those residents would then release the artifacts.

Nancy Vordtriede has suggested the Parkey Station at Francis Park as a possible site. She said that the building

is already being used by many committees of the Association, and that it would be a perfect site for historical artifacts.

Since there are ongoing discussions about the rehab of the park, and about installing security cameras within the park, the Committee strongly encourages you and the Association to include this proposal in these discussions.

We would very much appreciate your and Ken's thoughts about our proposal. Thank you.



# 1. HANDBALL COURT



Court floor is cracking and settling. Water settles on paving and drainage needs improvement.




Wall boards are deteriorating and bowing. Fasteners are missing.



Screen dividers between courts are ripped.

Wall supports are deteriorating, bowing and/or missing.



## 2. RACQUETBALL COURT



Access to courts is limited by narrow door opening.



Roof structure is in fair condition. Appears to have been painted recently.



Back of handball court is utilized for soccer kicking wall. Wall is solid but grading in kicking area should be improved for better drainage.



Pavement inside and outside of courts are cracking and settling. Water is not draining properly from courts.



Walls of structure are solid and in good condition. Windows are scratched but not cracked.

### 3. LILY POND



Pool overflow structures are small and frequently clog.



Water input.



Pool edge is slightly lower than adjacent grades. Water can lap out of pool into adjacent lawn areas in windy conditions.



Pond cracks have been filled and pond structure was painted with waterproofing to prevent leaks.




Water line location and access. This area of adjacent lawn is lightly low and usually wet.



Note: Pond maintenance crew reported leaking from the pool prior to recent water proofing of the pool structure. A mechanical review of plumbing and drainage structures was not part of this visual assessment. However, it is recommended that all valves and seals be examined, cleaned and reassembled annually in order to remove sediment and deposits that can cause leaking.


## 4. PARK STRUCTURE

Structure attic is open to access.


## 4. PARK STRUCTURE CONT.

## 5. TENNIS COURTS




Tennis court fencing is in need of repair. It is leaning, rusting and broken in some locations. Fences are in traditional rectangular configuration with 90 angles at corners.
