I. POLICY

It is the policy of the St. Louis City Division of Corrections that no officer, employee or contracted staff of the Division will permit medical or drug experimentation involving the use of inmate subjects to be undertaken by either medical staff or outside researchers.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES

The facility Executive staff, healthcare providers, and staff having daily contact with the inmate population are responsible for ensuring that the provisions of this policy are adhered to.

III. DEFINITIONS

Drug Experimentation: Research involving the testing of drug effectiveness and side effects utilizing inmates as subjects.

Medical Experimentation: Internal and/or body surface biological experimentation involving inmate subjects.

IV. PROCEDURES

Any employee, officer or member of the healthcare staff who receives a request for, or observes an action which involves or appears to involve, medical or drug experimentation using inmate subjects will immediately report such contact and/or observations to the Detention Center superintendent who reports to the
