4 Applications for AT and T as follows:

1. placing a new buried cable in the alley between Wabada and Lotus, beginning at 5754 Wabada and ending at 5602 Wabada. This is to restore service for customers in this area. Starting in the alley at Goodfellow between Wabada and Lotus, etc.
2. starting at the corner of No. 10th at 2305 No. Broadway access manhole for splicing purposes only. At the corner of 9th and Monroe at 2222 No. 9th access manhole for splicing purposes only. From existing HH at 201 Madison bore a total of 507' to a new 4x4x4' etc.
3. starting at side of 3711 Market, along Spring Ave., to place a new 4" conduit for 150 feet to the handhole at Foundry Way. AT and T to place 50' of new conduit from manhole 1013 to rear of 3691 Market. AT and T to place 190 feet of new conduit from Foundry Way, etc.
4. AT and T Contractors to access manhole at the intersection of 11th and Chambers and bore 65' north to pole in front of 2001 No. 11th. Then AT and T Contractor to access manhole at the intersection of Madison and 10th and bore 120' south to pole at the side of 926 Madison, etc.

6 Applications for Charter as follows:

1. starting at the existing Charter pole one south behind 3460 Hampton Ave. in alley boring north to Marquette Ave. setting a vault to make a turn to Hampton Ave. Crossing Hampton to the southwest side to place another vault to turn up north on Hampton Ave., etc.
2. starting in front of 214 Vandeventer at existing vault bore 269 feet north to alley. Turn and bore east in alley 459 feet to end of alley. The owner of the project is placing conduit toward the alley. Total footage of this project is 728 feet City Foundry project.
3. starting at the existing Charter manhole at 801-899 No. 10th St. (parking), Charter would like to bore north 362' and ending on private property of 901 No. 10th St.
4. starting at the corner of Wise Ave. and Macklind Ave. from there bore south on Macklind on the east curb line plus or minus 15ft off of the curb line 754ft to 1319 Macklind Ave. to the property line and enter building.
5. starting in the alley on the side of 1539 Vail Place from there bore 684ft north on Vail Place plus or minus 15ft off of the west curb line to 1900 Park Ave. ending address entering the building on the east side.
6. starting at the pole in alley behind 4398 Holly Hills we will bore northwest 27' to Christy Dr. then bore northeast 303' across Holly Hills to pole in alley next to 4393 Holly Hills and riser up pole.

MCI Metro Access, bore and place 1-2.00" conduit and manhole for new fiber. Starting at an existing handhole at 6900 Clayton Ave., bore NW along the south side of Clayton Ave. for 563' ending at 7036 Clayton Ave. Place new handhole.
