Joint recommendation that 2 applications from Charter Communications

1. Place fiber cable starting in the back of 4900 Manchester, bore 223' across the intersection, place vault in sidewalk at 1234 South Kingshighway, bore 100' south and place vault by tracks be approved subject to certain conditions.
2. Start at existing Charter tap at the back of 3700 Union, bore east across alley way to enter on to private property of 5245 Natural Bridge

Joint recommendation that 13 applications from Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri be approved subject to certain conditions:

1. Relocating OH lines from 1501 S. 7th to street along south side of Park Avenue,
2. Pole change out dig 12" diameter hole, 6.5' deep to set new pole,
3. Install duct bank/MH/cable from existing MH at intersection of Lindell and Euclid west to York Avenue and north on York trench for duct bank w/bucket,

4. Install new conduit and cable from existing pole at Alfred and alley to 5G pole with meter base approximately 105' of open trench construction,
5. Install cable from existing MH at Clark & N. Broadway to customer meter equipment on N. Broadway northeast of Clark Approximately 72' of open trench construction,
6. Install cable from existing MH northeast on Walnut to customer meter equipment on Walnut northwest of N. Broadway approximately 42' of open trench construction,
7. Install new cable from existing MH at Spruce & Memorial Dr. to customer meter equipment on Memorial Dr. north east of Spruce,
8. Install new cable from existing MH at Market & N. 4th to customer meter equipment on N. 4th southwest of Market approximately 118' of open trench construction,
9. Install cable from existing MH at Washington & 8th to customer meter equipment on 8th St. south of Washington approximately 87' of open trench construction,
10. Install new cable from existing MH at Chestnut St. & 7th to customer meter equipment on 7th St. south of Chestnut approximately 66' of open trench construction.
11. Reconductoring along Soulard St. from 13th to 11th Streets and also reconductoring down alley between Tucker Blvd. and 11th Street, one block of Soulard Street
12. Install new conduit and cable from existing pole No. 81798 at Alfred Avenue and alley to 5G pole with meter base approximately 435' of open trench construction.
13. Install new conduit from existing MH at Olive Street & 11th Street, connect to customer installed conduit on Olive, install new cable from MH approximately 70' of open trench construct
