Joint recommendation that 4 applications from Charter Communications be approved subject to certain conditions:

1. Starting at pole in alley behind 6424 East Ct. bore north east 60' under Kings Dr. Then bore north west 90' up Kings Dr. next to 4611 Gravois Ave.,
2. Place vault 30x48x36 at the south west corner of Washington Ave. and Tucker Blvd. replacing the vault that is currently there,
3. Bore and place a coax cable starting at the MH south of 1025 Washington 221' south to the MH at 11th and St. Charles Ave.,
4. Start at existing vault in front of 2500 Abbott Pl. bore 395' south turn and bore 291' east to riser pole before bridge, cross bridge aerial attaching to the other Ameren pole bore 253' to pole located at the edge of the parking lot at 7601 Southwest.

3. Place conduit for new fiber starting at HH across from 4932 Oleatha bore 450' southwest along Miami St. place HH at 4967 Miami bore 425' west place a HH at 5001 Miami bore north 25' on Hereford St. ending and placing a HH at the side of 5001 Miami,
4. Start at 5601 Tholozan place HH bore east along north side of Tholozan place HH at 5349 Tholozan bore 386' south along east side of Macklind end at HH at side of 5350 Mardel,
5. Start at existing HH at 4931 Oleatha to southern edge of median area place HH bore west

ending across east bound lane of Oleatha from 4932 Oleatha,

6. Start at Arsenal place HH bore and place conduit north along west side of Tamm place HH at side of 6402 Hoffman bore north along west side of Tamm place new HH near 3001 Tamm.
