3 Applications for AT and T as follows:

1. start at an existing AT and T handhole located at the corner of Eveline and Knox (side of 1918 Knox). From this hand hole ore north down Knox Ave. 1' in front of the sidewalk for 213'. At Amanda St. turn and bore east 2' from the curb for 189', then turn and bore 8' onto the private property at the front of 6134 Amanda St.,
2. contractor to direct bury 244' of copper phone cable from AT and T manhole 3037 in the intersection of No. 25th St. and Salisbury St. approximate address is 2322 Salisbury St. Will bore/trench cable 144' to the south in east ROW of 25th St. 8' from edge of pavement. Bore will turn east 23' to utility pole riser at the rear of 2333 Mallinckrodt and,
3. at 901 Skinker to upsize existing HH to new 3x5x3'. Then dig 13' to new 4x4 pad with fiber distribution box. Also from new HH will bore to multiple riser pole locations.

Charter Communications, starting at the pedestal on corner of So. Boyle and Duncan bore UG down the side of Duncan 328'. Across from 4340 Duncan turn and bore under Duncan, continue down the alley to back corner of 4340 Duncan and set a pedestal.
