The **Building Union Diversity (BUD)** is an 8-week *pre-apprenticeship* training program for ***laid off*** and ***long term unemployed*** individuals interested in pursuing careers in construction. Taught by nationally certified and industry approved apprenticeship training specialists in state-of-the-art training centers, the program will cover topics specific to participating BUD Construction trades. Eligible participants *may* be provided with work-related equipment, transportation to training sites and a training allowance (upon completion of the program).

PARTICIPANTS MUST BE:

- 18 years of age or older
- Laid off or Long-Term Unemployed
- Able to pass a drug test

- Must come to SLATE, 1520 Market St, 3rd Floor, St. Louis, MO 63103, from 9 am. to 4 pm., Monday –Friday
- Complete an application and assessment
