

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Public notice is hereby given that The Industrial Development Authority of the City of St. Louis, Missouri (the “Authority”) will hold a public hearing at 1520 Market Street, Suite 2000, St. Louis, Missouri 63103, on November 12, 2020, commencing at 1:00 p.m., regarding the proposed issuance by the Authority of its educational facility revenue bonds in one or more series in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$40,000,000 (the “Bonds”). The Bonds are proposed to be issued for the purpose of making a loan to Friends of Confluence Academy, a Missouri nonprofit corporation (the “Corporation”), to refinance the Revenue Bonds (Confluence Academy Project), Series 2007A, and other debt obligations of the Corporation and Confluence Academy, a Missouri nonprofit corporation (the “Charter School”), which were issued to finance or refinance the acquisition, construction, renovation, furnishing and equipping of existing educational facilities owned, leased or otherwise operated by the Corporation or the Charter School, and located at 3017 North 13th Street (Old North Academy), 5421 Thekla Avenue (Aspire Academy), 4235 South Compton Avenue and 3112 Meramec Street (South City Academy), 701-717 North Grand Boulevard (Grand Center Arts Academy), 3625 Grandel Square (Sun Theater), and 310 North 15th Street (Confluence Preparatory Academy), all in the City of St. Louis, Missouri (collectively, the “Project”).

The hearing will be open to the public. All interested persons may attend the hearing and will have an opportunity to express their views with respect to the above-mentioned projects, including the location and nature of the facilities and the issuance of bonds therefor. Written comments with respect to the project may also be submitted to the undersigned prior to the hearing. Additional information regarding the project and the bond issue may be obtained in advance of the hearing from the undersigned. The Authority makes reasonable accommodations for any known disability that may interfere with a person’s ability to participate in public meetings. Persons needing an accommodation must notify the Authority, by telephone or in writing, no later than five days prior to the hearing to allow adequate time to make needed arrangements.
